

Dear friends,

“It’s that most wonderful time of the year!” The weeks following Thanksgiving and leading to Christmas are, indeed, special. For us as Catholics the weeks after Christmas are equally special as we will have an entire season to take in the mystery of God’s love that we celebrate at Christmas. Every year the Church invites us to make a spiritual pilgrimage to Bethlehem. Advent prepares us for this annual journey that will lead us on Christmas Eve and Christmas morning to break into the joyous strains of “O Come, Let Us Adore Him!”

When we prepare for a journey, such as the pilgrimage we are now making, two things are important. We make preparations for the journey beforehand and we keep in mind our destination. Remembering the destination keeps us focused and also gives us strength to endure any of the difficulties we may encounter on the journey. I think of “National Lampoon’s Vacation,” the classic comedy that details the adventures of the Griswald family as they make their ‘pilgrimage’ across the country to Wally World. Keeping the destination in mind kept them going through a series of mishaps and setbacks.

Our Advent Pilgrimage will lead us once again to a manger in Bethlehem and the mystery that is revealed at Christmas. “For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son” (John 3:16). In the midst of the excitement and chaos of this wonderful time of year, we need to make time for reflection so that we can appreciate the gift that is given.

To help create a time and space for this reflection, each Sunday of Advent the Blessed Sacrament is exposed at Christ the King from 5:00 pm until midnight. The Third Sunday of Advent those hours are extended from 2:00 pm through 7:00 am on Monday morning. The very same Lord whose birth we celebrate at Christmas is present in the great Sacrament of his Body and Blood. “O Come, Let us Adore Him!” Whenever the Blessed Sacrament is exposed on the altar, at least one person must always be present. That is why we have sign-up sheets for adoration. Please consider signing up for an hour of adoration during Advent. Everyone, however, is welcome at any time to come and pray. What a beautiful Advent tradition this would be for parish families. Imagine how enthusiastically children would respond to the invitation, “Let’s go see Jesus!”

Christmas is all about a gift that was given. God knew what we most needed. The world needed a Savior and what a Savior he has given us! Jesus came to save us from sin. All of us are in need of this Savior. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available each Sunday of Advent from 2:00 pm - 4:00 pm. The sacrament will also be available Saturday evening, December 19, from 6:30 pm. - 8:30 pm. There is no better way to welcome Jesus into our lives than to welcome the gift that he brings to us at Christmas and always - reconciliation with God and man.

Let the pilgrimage begin!

I want to start by thanking each and everyone of you in advance for your generous gifts and unwavering support of the annual Giving Tree Project. It is already in full swing at this time and we plan to continue assisting the Children's Services Families at Noble of Indiana. As expected, our goal is to keep everyone safe and healthy, so we will experience a few minor changes. But I promise we will be back to normal next year.

Instead of hanging individual gift request ornaments on the tree, we are asking that you would please donate a gift card(s) in the same amount that you would normally spend on a gift. If you have donated one large gift card in the past, consider dividing that into smaller increments so we can share the love. The gift card(s) can be dropped off at the parish office or placed in the offertory basket in an envelope(\*) labeled "Giving Tree."



If you would prefer to donate cash or write a check, the process is the same. Place the cash or check in an envelope(\*) clearly marked "Giving Tree," and put it in the offertory basket. **You are also welcome to give online by clicking on the Online Giving Link on our home page, [www.ck-indy.org](http://www.ck-indy.org), by December 6, 2020**

Since we will not have traditional wrapped gifts for the families this year, all donations will be used to purchase gift cards. The gift cards will be equally distributed amongst the families based on the individual family's specific needs and size.

If you choose to donate gift cards instead of cash or a check, please consider general department stores where a variety of purchases can be made. Such as Target, Meijer, Walmart, Big Lots, Kohl's, Macy's, Penney's. **Gift card and monetary donations are due by December 6, 2020.** We will also need Kroger gift cards to purchase turkeys and groceries. Please do not box or wrap the gift cards. We will be packaging everything separately to keep everyone safe and healthy this holiday season.

Pre-labeled envelopes(\*) will be placed in the vestibule if you'd like to make a donation while you are attending Mass. Or feel free to take an envelope(\*) and return it with your donation to the offertory basket next weekend or to the parish office during the week.

For many, many years Christ The King Parish has very generously provided for 100+ families. This year will be no different! I simply ask for your faithful prayers. Prayers for The Giving Tree volunteers and prayers for the families we serve. And I will continue to pray in thanksgiving for the kindness and generosity of our Christ The King Family.




