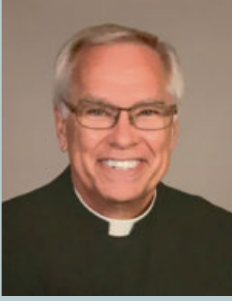

Dear friends,

We have passed the halfway point of Lent. Easter Sunday is just three weeks away! Our celebration of Easter, the greatest of all Christian feasts, will be preceded by the liturgies of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday. These three days are called the Easter 'Triduum,' from the Latin word for 'three days.' Let us mark our calendars and plan on being present for the very special liturgies of this week that we call Holy Week. It is a week unlike any other!

The Triduum is so important that it has its own period of preparation. Lent is the season of grace that invites us to prepare our hearts and minds to celebrate the greatest love the world has ever known – a love stronger than death. Let us take advantage of the remaining opportunities we have to do this preparation for Easter.

One of the opportunities that is available to us is a very simple, but a very rich devotion called the Way of the Cross. Each Friday of Lent parishioners gather in church at 6:00 pm to walk with Jesus the final steps of his earthly life. The prayers and reflections help us to connect Jesus's way of the cross two thousand years ago with our own lives today. The prayer usually lasts about twenty minutes.

The history of the Way of the Cross dates back to pilgrimages that Christians would make to the Holy Land where they would physically walk the 'Via Dolorosa', tracing the steps of Jesus from his condemnation to death by Pontius Pilate to his burial in the tomb. Through the centuries, pilgrims were often prevented from walking the Via Dolorosa due to war and unrest in the Holy Land.

Saint Francis of Assisi is credited with placing 'stations' marking the final steps of Jesus outside of parish churches where people could make a spiritual pilgrimage. The practice became so popular that Stations of the Cross are a staple in Catholic churches throughout the world today. Tapestries, along the back wall of Christ the King, depict the final fourteen steps of Jesus' life.

If you haven't participated in a Way of the Cross this Lent, please bring the family and join us on the remaining Fridays of Lent. It is a beautiful way to prepare for the Easter Triduum and our celebration of Jesus' resurrection from the dead.

See you at the Stations of the Cross – and Mass!

Will we have the Blessing of the Easter Baskets this year?

Yes! Or should I say, 'Tak!' The Blessing of the Easter Baskets is a treasured tradition from Eastern Europe. It is especially popular in Poland. We will celebrate this beautiful tradition at Christ the King on the morning of Holy Saturday. The Blessing of the Easter Baskets comes from a time when the Lenten fast was extremely strict, and foods such as meat, eggs, fats, and sweets were not eaten at all during Lent. On Holy Saturday morning, families would place these foods in a beautifully decorated baskets and bring them to church where the food would be blessed in preparation for the festive meal of Easter Sunday. In this rich tradition, each food is blessed with a special prayer that connects it in some way to the story of salvation that culminates with the death and resurrection of Jesus. All are welcome to the Blessing of the Easter Baskets that will take place in church on Saturday, April 16, at 11:00 am.

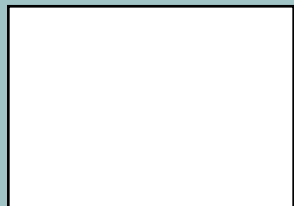

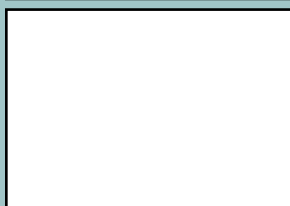

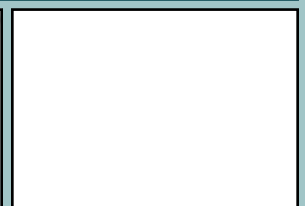
