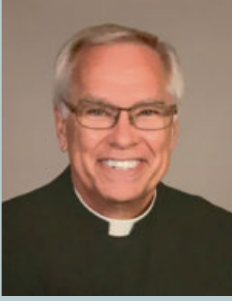

The Bishops of the United States want to promote greater understanding and appreciation for this great gift and, over the course of the next three years, will organize events at the parish, diocesan and national level. The revival will culminate with a National Eucharistic Congress to be held in Indianapolis, July 17-21, 2024. The last National Eucharistic Congress was held in Philadelphia in 1976 and drew 1.5 million people. We are blessed at Christ the King to have an Adoration Chapel. 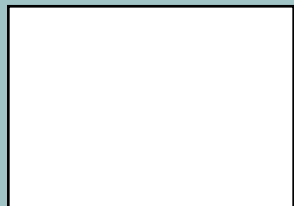

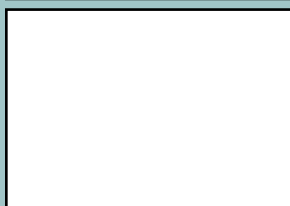

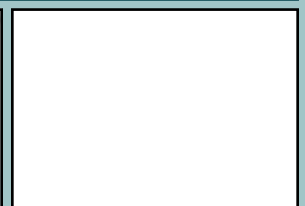
