We venerate the saints because they have lived the teachings of Jesus in such a way as to inspire us in our daily quest to be holy.

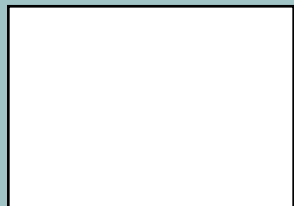

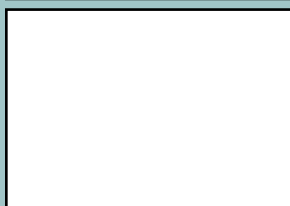

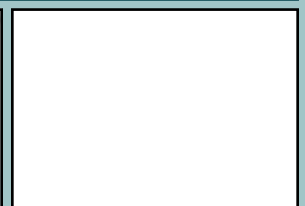
