

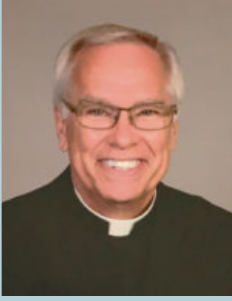

Dear friends,

It's official! Fr. Rob Hankee has been appointed pastor of Christ the King! His appointment is effective at twelve noon, Wednesday, July 6, 2022.

Fr. Rob was ordained to the priesthood on June 1, 2002. He is a Bishop Chatard High School graduate and spent a summer as a seminarian here at Christ the King during the time of Monsignor Tuohy. During Fr. Rob's 20 years of priesthood, he has served as associate pastor and pastor of several parishes, as well as chaplain to both Cardinal Ritter High School and Father Thomas Scecina Memorial High School. He is currently pastor of St. Thomas the Apostle in Fortville, and Chaplain Coordinator of Scecina High School. The Archbishop has named Fr. QUESTION OF THE WEEK

What is a Third Order? I was talking to a parishioner who is a Third Order Carmelite. What exactly does that mean?

A Third Order is made up of lay persons who strive to live the spirit or charism of a particular Religious Order in their everyday lives. Carmelites, Dominicans, Franciscans and Benedictines all have 'third orders.' Men and women who are members of a Third Order live and work in the world and gather at regular intervals for prayer and formation in the spirituality of the particular Religious Order to which they are associated. They participate in the good works of the Order. Third Orders offer laypersons the opportunity to grow in holiness. Third Order Carmelites, for example, dedicate themselves to prayer and contemplation and devotion to the Blessed Mother which is at the heart of Carmelite spirituality.

Many Religious Orders include a 'First Order' made up of the male religious, often the first founded, and a 'Second Order' made up of female religious, and a 'Third Order' made up of lay men and women.
