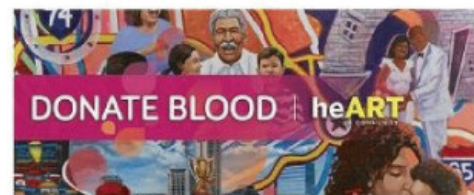
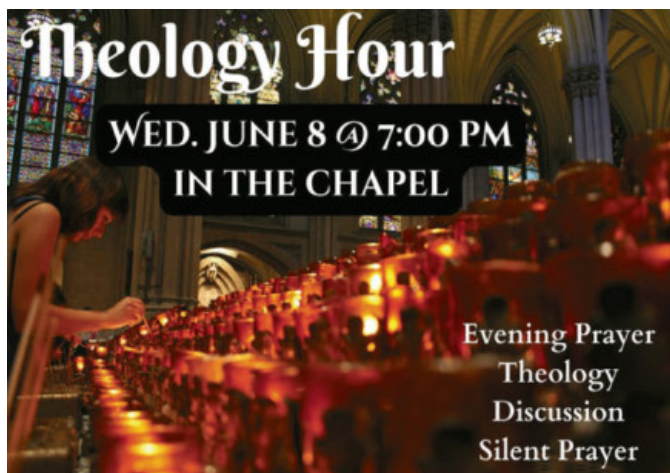

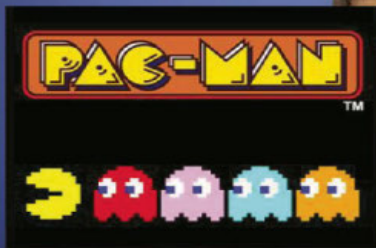

QUESTION OF THE WEEK

What is a 'convalidation'?

In order to enter into a sacramental marriage, a Catholic who marries another Catholic or a Catholic who marries a baptized Christian from another religious tradition, must do so in the presence of a Catholic priest and two witnesses. Catholics who have married outside the Church in a civil ceremony or before a minister of another faith tradition who wish to have their marriage recognized as a sacramental marriage in the Catholic Church may request to have their marriage 'convalidated.' By means of the convalidation ceremony, the marriage is recognized by the Catholic Church and the Catholic party may participate in a full sacramental life. Prior to the ceremony, the priest working with the couple makes sure that there are no impediments to the sacramental marriage such as prior marriages. A Catholic who may have married outside the Church is encouraged to talk with a parish priest who will help the person take the steps necessary to have a marriage convalidated.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

On June 4 we will ordain two new priests, Deacon Michael Clawson and Deacon Matthew Perronie. We had two transitional deacons ordained earlier this spring and our future ordination classes look strong.



The weekend of June 4 and 5, we will have our annual collection in support of our seminarians currently studying for future ministry in the Church. This collection helps cover the expenses involved in the education and formation of our future priests. At this point in time, we are blessed with 25 men studying for the priesthood: ten at Bishop Simon Brute College Seminary and thirteen at Saint Meinrad School of Theology. We hope to add 4 to 6 men to this number for next year. The average cost per student for educational expenses is \$40,000 per year. The United Catholic Appeal and proceeds from endowments also support formation for our seminarians, but those funds do not fulfill the entire need. All donations to this special annual collection will go directly toward the payment of these expenses.

In the name of all who minister in the Archdiocese of Indianapolis, I ask you to be generous in supporting the educational needs of our future priests. Most important, I encourage you to pray for priests and seminarians and for a generous increase in vocations to priesthood and consecrated life. Thank you for your support.
