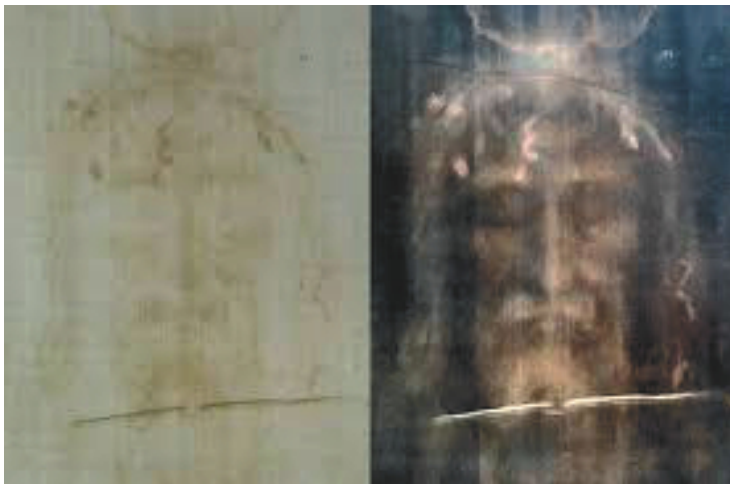
this weekend are Ginny Schaeffer and Joan Zehnder who are both experienced retreat leaders for women recovering from abuse.
