## Walking the Good Red Road: Nicholas Black Elk's Journey to Sainthood

The documentary *Walking the Good Red Road: Nicholas Black Elk's Journey to Sainthood* will air in Louisville on Sunday, June 14, at 5 pm on WHAS 11 TV, the local ABC affiliate. This program came about through the collaboration of the Diocese of Rapid City, promoters of Black Elk's cause for sainthood, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) Catholic Communication Campaign, and a well-respected production company (NewGroup Media) that has produced many programs for USCCB over the years.

This retelling of Black Elk's life and legacy relies heavily on archival photographs and publications, expert interviews, and historical reenactments on the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation in South Dakota. According to records from the Diocese of Rapid City, Black Elk was born around 1865. He came from a family of medicine men and he carried on their work. He was at the Battle of Little Big Horn close to the Montana-Wyoming border in 1876. Around 1877, he joined Buffalo Bill's Wild West

show and toured in Europe. He returned to the United States in 1889.

Through his interaction with Jesuit priests, he converted to the Catholic faith and was baptized on December 6, 1904, the feast of St. Nicholas. One biographer said he took the name Nicholas because he was inspired by the saint's generosity.
