extra sandwich and snack to help ease the burden of hunger during these trying times. In the past few months, the majority of guests have been homeless.

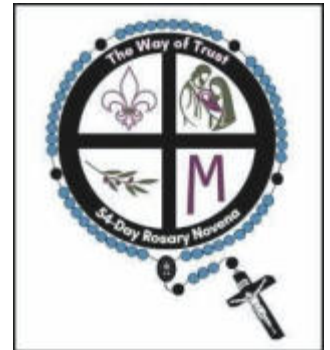
