Feast of San Lorenzo Ruiz de Manila

Our 32nd annual observance of the Feast of St. Lorenzo Ruiz de Manila at the Cathedral is fast approaching. It will be a little different this year due to Covid 19, but we still have much to celebrate. Our Mass will be on Sunday, September 27, at 5:30 pm, and Fr. Aldrin Tayag will concelebrate with Fr. Martin Linebach. The statue and banner commemorating the first Filipino to be martyred for the Christian faith will lead the procession at the beginning of Mass.



Although this year we will not have the opportunity to enjoy the hospitality and fun of dining together on dishes so generously and wonderfully prepared and served by members our Filipino Community, the very dedicated and faithful planning team is still determined to raise money for the Cathedral Scholarship Fund, which helps students whose parents have limited income, and attend a Catholic school. In the 2019-2020 academic year, funds were used to help two minority students attend local Catholic elementary schools. This year we are assisting two elementary students and one high school student.

Meals are placed on a tray for picking up at the door to Sandefur Dining Room while dining in has been halted due to the pandemic. Thanks to the generosity of donors, we have been able to continue adding an extra sandwich and snack to help ease the burden of hunger during these trying times. In the past few months, the majority of guests have been homeless.

Our **State ID Voucher Program** is also in operation now that some government offices have re-opened.

Viongozi Parish Ministry Leadership Program Zoom Webinars

The Office of Multicultural Ministry's Viongozi Ministry Leadership Program will offer two webinar classes in September and October via Zoom cast. They are: "Tools for Effective Ministry," Wednesday, September 30, 2020 presented by Deacon James R. Turner; and "What it Means to be a Welcoming Church," Wednesday, October 14, 2020 presented by Rev. John Judie. Both classes will run from 6 pm - 8 pm. The fee is \$10 per person, per class.
