Aside from what was shared by conversation, there was another huge finding—we don't have current phone numbers for a significant portion of our parish.

Since the pandemic began in March, the regular life of the parish has been altered significantly. Our ability to worship together in great numbers, meet for formation and social celebrations, even offer community outreach has had to change. The social unrest in downtown has also added yet another layer of challenges. No one has been untouched.

Just as each member has a personal story of meeting the challenges of this historic time, so does our parish—with live stream Masses, initiative, workarounds, serving daily lunch out of doors, resuming ID vouchers when government offices reopened, zoom meetings, our prayer group always at the ready, and stepped up communication including this most recent effort of parishioner to parishioner phone calls.

We have gone back to our regular worship schedule and we have free parking for weekend Masses. We want everyone back...and yet we know not everyone should be back yet... for our own safety or the safety of those in our care.

Our goal continues to be to stay as connected as possible.
