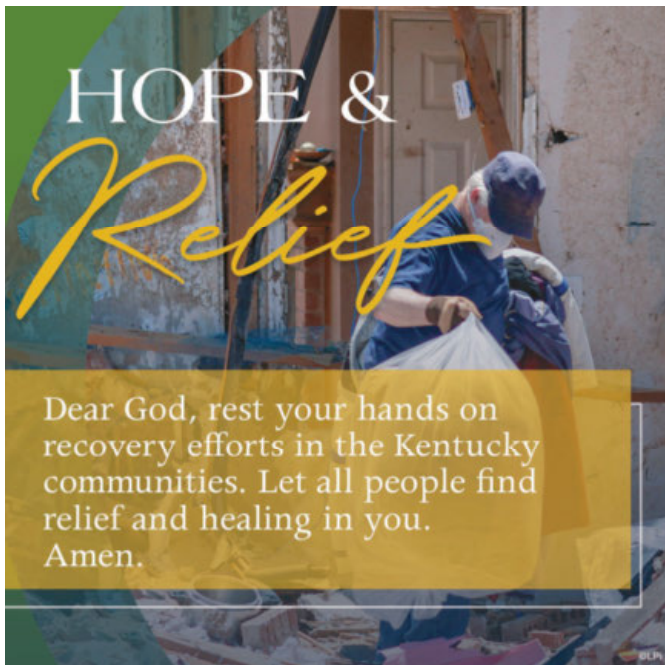

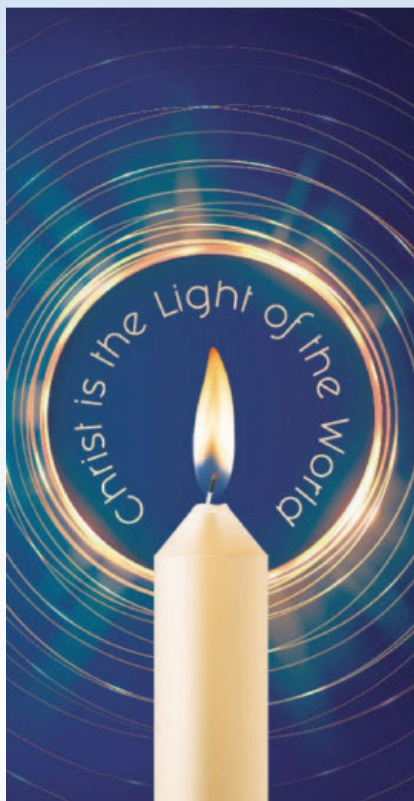


## In the Community
