LETTER FROM FR. TOM: I am writing this on the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph - our parish feast day - which caused me to wonder, "What do pastors dream about for their parishes?" As pastor, I dream that every parishioner knows and loves Jesus Christ, and lives his or her life the way that Christ and his Church call us to live. Then, another idea came to my mind. I would like every parishioner to see their identity as part of our parish. For years, I thought, "How can we bring our community together? How can we help people to see themselves as part of something greater than themselves?" We are part of the Body of Christ. Our community is something special. I would love to have everyone know that they are part of a community and are loved, and then they, in turn, will love others.

How do we develop that identity? This is something that happens in prayer. When we pray for someone, we begin to care for that person. God's love for that person slowly becomes our love for that person. Here are some prayer ideas for our community:

- 1. When you are at Mass, look around and pray for the people you are worshipping with. Look at their faces and pray for them. Some you may know, and others you may not know. But then when you see them out and about, in the community you will think, "I prayed for them."
- 2. Also, while at Mass, look at the empty pews and pray for those who are not there. Let the empty pews be a symbol for you. Those pews may be empty because some people are too sick to come or they may be homebound. They may be away traveling and need our prayers for safety. They may be struggling with their faith and not coming, in which case, they need our prayers even more.
- 3. Often when a person is in need of prayer, a vigil candle is lit. Each candle is a prayer. Look around the church at all of the flickering vigil candles, read the book of intentions, and then pray for all the prayers of the people. In this way, we can help by praying for other people's intentions.

We pray for each other, and we ask others to pray for us. This is how we participate in the Communion of Saints. If we pray this way every time we go to Mass, then our community will become stronger, and we will identify as Catholics, and as part of the Holy Family Parish community. Let us unite, bring Christ to the world, and make our world a better place. As pastor, that is my dream for our parish!
