

LETTER FROM FR. TOM: Pope Francis has named the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time (this weekend) "Sunday of the Word of God." He would like everyone in the entire world to think about how they will bring scripture into their lives. I would hope that every Catholic has a bible and reads it on a regular basis. When we approach reading the bible, we can do it in two different ways.

First, we can pray with the bible. A few weeks ago, I talked about a method of praying with scripture called Lectio Divina. The goal of praying with the bible is to spend time with God. His word-the scriptures-are spoken to you. As you read the scriptures, you are raising your heart and mind to God. When you pray with scripture, you think about the scenes. You use your imagination and place yourself into the story. The goal is to come to know and love God.

The second way to approach the bible is to study scripture. When you study, you ask "What does this passage mean? Why did the author use those words?" You compare this passage to other passages of scripture. You study the historical background of the text, the characters and the author. We study Scripture to learn about God and about God's plan for humanity throughout history. It is often good to combine the two methods study scripture, and once you know all about the passage, pray with scripture.

One of the benefits of being a priest is that I need to prepare a homily almost every day. That means I have many opportunities to read scripture, think about it, pray with it, and then think of ways to share it with others. Studying and praying with scripture is at the heart of my spiritual life. This is such a wonderful way to come to know God! I would encourage everyone to enter into the Word of God. This weekend is "Sunday of the Word of God." Let the Word of God change your life!
