FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

AS WE CELEBRATE THESE 12 DAYS OF CHRISTMAS, Joan Willey, Sr. Brenda, Nick Whyte, Tonette Webb and Tim Healy, and I wish you and your families heartfelt good wishes and blessings during this beautiful Christmas season.

Grateful for Mary's "Yes" to God's plan in giving us Jesus, we recommit ourselves to nurturing our faith in all the ways available to us, thankful to Jesus for giving us such intimate gifts of Himself in his Word (the Sacred Scriptures) and in His Body and Blood (the Eucharist.)

Several years ago we gave all parishioners a book titled REDISCOVER ADVENT, authored by Matthew Kelly. I have shared the following reflection from his book before, but I would like to repeat it, because I think it is important that we, as Catholics are aware of the positive impact our Church has on the world and in our own communities. Kelley speaks about the local contributions that Catholics make in every community. As an example he writes about a local chapter of Catholic Charities in Chicago, which in a year's time, provided 2.2 million free meals to the hungry and the needy in that area – that's over 6000 meals a day. It's an extraordinary contribution to the hungry and the needy in that area.

He imagines a large billboard on any of Chicago's busy freeways. No photos would be required, just this simple text: This year Catholic Charities will provide 2.2 million free meals to the hungry and the needy of Chicago. We don't ask them if they are Catholic – we just ask them if they are hungry. REDISCOVER CATHOLICISM.

Matthew feels that we as Catholics have forgotten our story, and in doing so, we have allowed the world to forget it as well. We have allowed the anti-Catholic segments of the media to distort our story on a daily basis. He points out that our history as a church is not without blemish and our future will not be without blemish, but our contribution is unmatched, and today, it's needed more than ever before.

We might reflect on some of the Catholic stories in our community – stories in our own homes, our parish, our town, our state. Can we play a part in shaping these stories? We, too, may have our "blemishes" but we are part of God's Church and God wants to use us to make the world a better place.

What "Catholic story" would you put on a billboard to help people REDISCOVER CATHOLICISM?
