FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

HAPPY EPIPHANY! AS WE CELEBRATE THESE 12 DAYS OF CHRISTMAS I, along with our parish staff, wish you and your families heartfelt good wishes and blessings as we enter into this New Year of 2022.

We are grateful for Mary's "Yes" to God's plan giving us Jesus, and thankful that Jesus gave us such intimate gifts of Himself in His Word (Sacred Scriptures) and His Body and Blood (Eucharist). Let us recommit ourselves to nurturing our faith in all the ways available to us.

CHALLENGE FOR THE NEW YEAR

TRUTH IS NOT PERSONAL: . . . many challenge and reject the objective nature of the Gospel. What's true for you isn't true for me, etc. – same in our culture. "Truth is no longer subjective or objective, it's personal." Don't like something? Tell everyone it never happened. . . it doesn't exist. Just spin your version. . .

This explains the rise of fake news and the shift in reporting that's happening....What's true on one network no longer appears to be true on another network.

"It seems....everyone is attempting to twist truth until it confirms their bias. All of this should make us shudder. After all, the most dangerous form of deception is selfdeception--easily becoming mass deception."

"There should be a deep mourning and concern over the death of objective truth, because with it comes the erosion of civility... So what can Christians do?

KEEP SOME DISTANCE FROM YOUR POLITICAL POSITIONS God is not a Republican, a Democrat, a conservative, a liberal or a socialist. He transcends all our political categories, however important they might be to us.

Politics matters, but it will never change the world the way the Gospel can (or has). Know this: *if God has all the same opinions your political party does, you're probably not worshipping God*.

LOVE PEOPLE WHO OPPOSE YOU

The tribalism that's emerging (I only hang out with people who look like me, ... agree with me) directly threatens our ability to value people different than ourselves. Jesus said our faith (would be) characterized ... by how deeply we love our enemies. Hung out with any enemies lately? Not to argue, but to listen? To Love?

A GREAT OPPORTUNITY

Keep confessing. Stay accountable. Take responsibility. Stop blaming. Keep hoping. Listen, and above all, keep loving. You (and everyone around you) will benefit.
