

A note from Fr. Ryan.....

We celebrate today the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord and the end of the Christmas season. The name of today's feast can be a little misleading so it's important to make some distinctions. Jesus' baptism was of a different kind and nature than ours.

When you and I were conceived, we inherited the guilt of original sin from our first parents. Through the washing of Holy Baptism, the guilt of original sin was removed from each of us. Jesus, not inheriting that guilt, did not require such a baptism. His baptism was like the anointing of the ancient kings of Israel.

Upon becoming a king of Israel, a man was to be anointed by a specific priest at the Temple in Jerusalem. He had olive oil poured over his head during this ritual and was, from that moment, called the "anointed of the Lord." The king was empowered by God and given a specific mission – to rule over the Chosen People.

Jesus' baptism is his own anointing as King of Israel. However, in place of olive oil, water and the Holy Spirit are poured over him. Therefore, his anointing is more perfect than that of old – he is not GIVEN a mission, but by his divine nature he himself IS the mission. He is sent forth visibly to redeem the universe and sent forth invisibly in the Holy Eucharist. (The Holy Spirit is also sent forth – visibly, in the Church, and invisibly, in our hearts!)

Today is a good time to remember that you also have a mission. You are sent to bring others to Jesus Christ and his Church by any means possible – most especially by your holy conduct and your witness of joy.
