

A note from

Fr. Ryan

I wrote a few weeks ago about the significance of facing east during Mass, but that is just one part of the importance of our church's sanctuary. The sanctuary itself is chock-full of significance for us!

The sanctuary contains five important pieces of furniture (or "appurtenances") that are arranged in the style of a Cross. From "top-to-bottom," we have the Crucifix, the tabernacle, and the altar; from "side-to-side" we have the ambo, the altar, and the sedilia.

The "ambo" is also called the "pulpit." It is the privileged place for reading Sacred Scripture. The "sedilia" is one, two, or three seats for the priest and any deacons that assist at Mass. These are both somewhat recent innovations and do not yet have much spiritual significance for us (as we have only been using them for about four hundred years).

We place a Crucifix in each sanctuary to remind ourselves that we are not simply sharing in a sacred meal. Rather, at each Mass, we stand at the foot of the Cross of Jesus — really and truly! When Mass begins, we are no longer in southern Indiana in 2021. We are on a hill outside Jerusalem on March 25th, 33AD. To drive home the presence of the Lord in our midst, we also place the tabernacle immediately underneath the Crucifix. Jesus truly lives among us in his Most Sacred Body and Blood.

At the base and center of the sanctuary is the altar of sacrifice. It is the physical space where the Holy Spirit makes our prayers to be with the Lord into a reality. He brings us to Jesus by bringing Jesus to us in the sacrifice of his Cross, re-presented (not "represented" but re-presented!) upon the altar.
