

A note from Fr. Ryan.....

From the Resurrection, the Creed moves on to say that Jesus "ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father." It's important to remember that the Ascension of Jesus was the moment when his physical body was removed from our present world and taken into heaven. You might wonder why he did this just as he promised that he would "be with you always, even until the end of the age."

Jesus isn't "gone" after his Ascension. Sure, he doesn't move around from place to place like you and I do. Rather, he remains with us in his Body and Blood in the Eucharist where he is really and truly present, just as he is present in heaven. We always have access to him so long as we are able to get to a church. Isn't it wonderful that God wants to be so close to us?

But wait, there's more! In some small way, we are present with Jesus in heaven already! Because you are connected to his Body in baptism, and because his Body is in heaven, then part of you goes with him wherever he is.
