



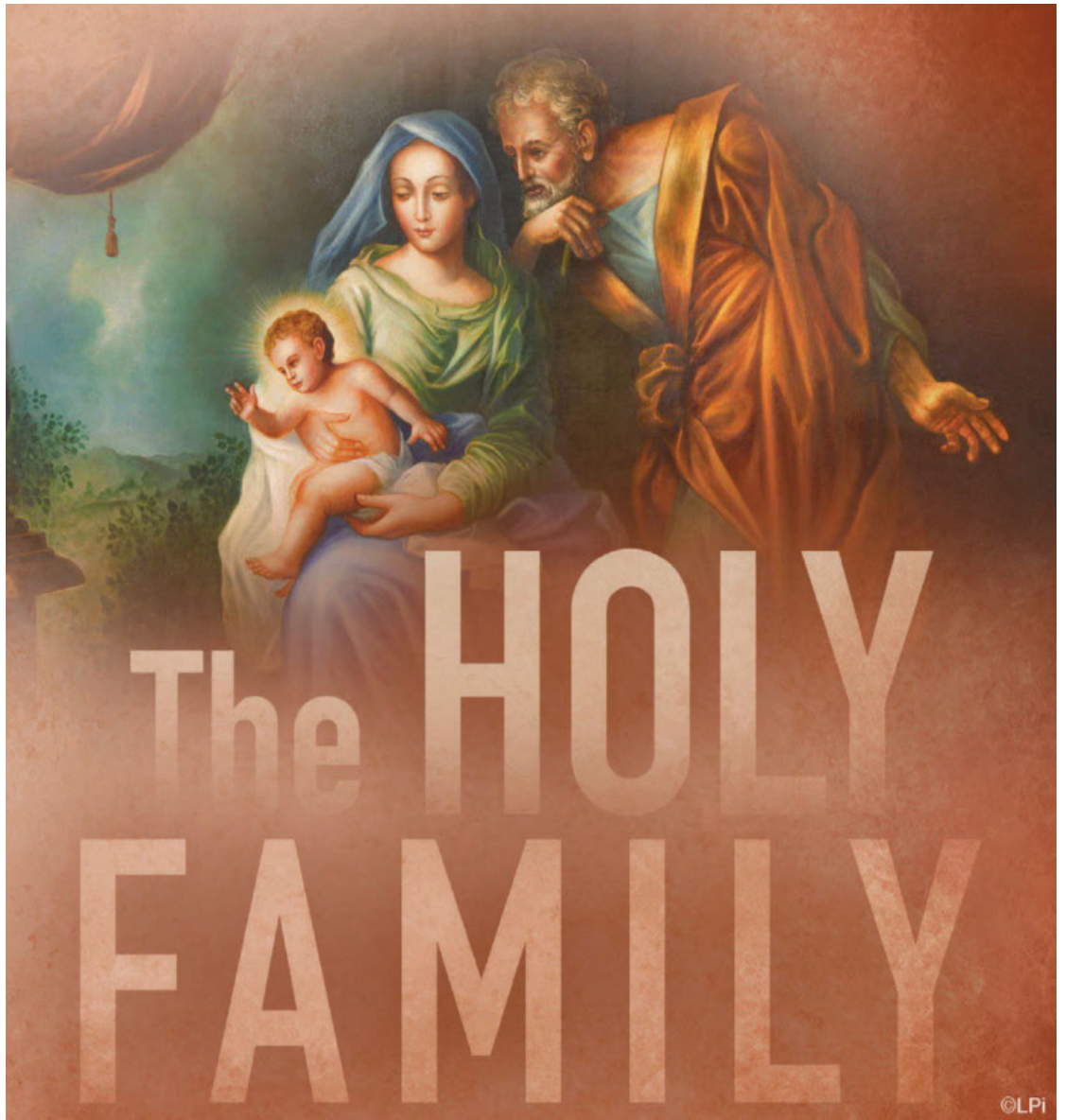

Celebrate your crew!

We have a wonderful combination of feasts this weekend. It includes Christmas and the Feast of the Holy Family. So much to celebrate that we might need to break it down a little bit. Imagine for a moment what a difference it has made that Jesus became flesh and lived among us.

All the precepts and the Commandments were words and teachings and prophecies before this. In Jesus, we got a glimpse of what it means to put those words into flesh. We also experience in Jesus the depth of God's love for us. His love moved him to share his son with us, with his unconditional love and willingness to shepherd us into one flock.

Since this one weekend also celebrates Jesus, Mary, and Joseph as the Holy Family, it might be a good time to check out if your family is acting as one flock. Are these gatherings times in which a stranger could walk in and see enough evidence to be convinced that our family is Christian? Are we taking some time during this great season of celebration to reach out to those who have less than we do and make sure that they have enough not just at this time of year, but every day?

I wish for each and every family and person who reads this an experience of God's nearness to you and God's love for you. I wish for each of us the courage to go beyond ourselves and to notice those around us, especially those who disagree with us and to take some time to listen, understand and love even if there are remaining disagreements or differences. I'm hoping for each of us the healing of wounds and a mending of divisions. I am praying for light to breakthrough in the midst of our darkness and new life to spring forth where things have been deadly. I wish you all a very blessed Christmas and a wonderful celebration of your family.

Let us have the courage to pray for peace in our world, in our city, in our churches, in our schools, in our families, and in our own minds and hearts. Let us take our weapons of war, whether that is a sharp tongue or a gun, and use those resources for the building up of a world of peace. Begin to dream the dream of God and live the dream of God, one person at a time, one word at a time, and one choice at a time. May you be blessed in this beautiful season.

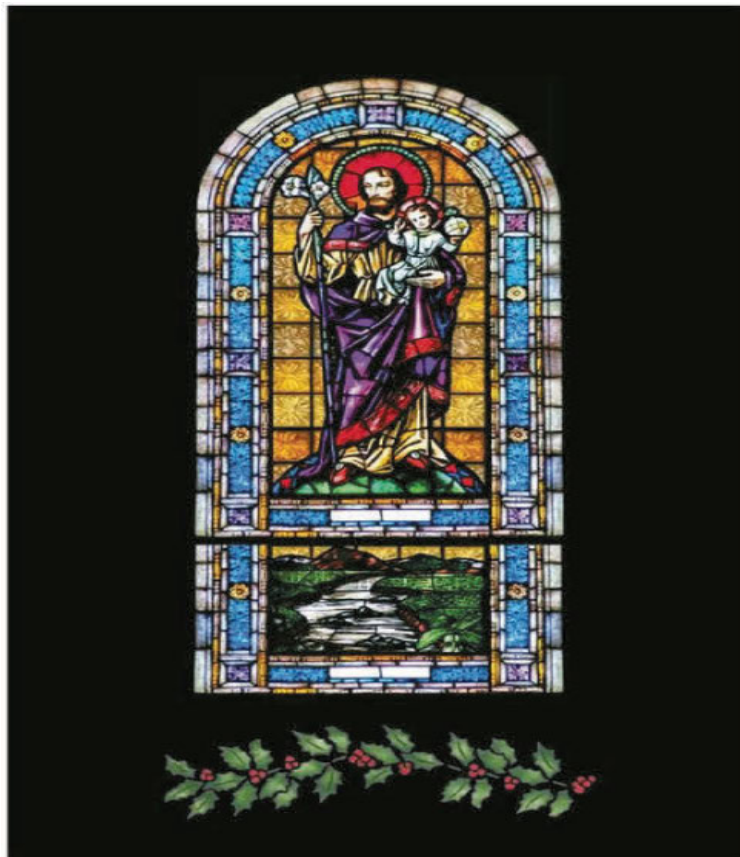
