CONVERSATIONS ON the Journey



After Mass last weekend, Lucy stopped and asked me a question. Her initial question led to more questions. It turned into a conversation that could have gone on longer. But I had to get to the next Mass, so I'll continue our conversation here.

Her question was, "Who wrote the Book of Revelation?" I said, "The Apostle John wrote Revelation and actually several other books in the New Testament." John wrote: the fourth Gospel, 1 John, 2 John, 3 John, and Revelation.

Lucy said, "I went through years of Catholic school and wasn't taught even the basics of the Bible." She said, "We're similar in age, did you learn about the Bible where you grew up?" I told her no, and that fact has motivated me to share knowledge of the Bible and our rich faith with others.

When we were younger, knowledge of the Bible and how to use it could have been taught much better.

The Bible can help us understand the meaning of life. It can give us hope. The Bible is the Story of Salvation.



About 10 years ago I ran across a resource created by Jeff Cavins called **The Bible Timeline**. This resource can help you understand the Story of Salvation more clearly and quickly.

The Bible Timeline breaks down the Bible into 12 time periods. Within each time period, it lists one or more books from the Bible. To get the whole

story of salvation you don't have to read the whole Bible. The Bible Timeline tells you which books to read within each time period.

The story of salvation history can be read from 12 Old Testament books and 2 New Testament books. To some, that sounds better than having to read all 73 books of the Bible.

After reading the 14 narrative books, you can use The Bible Timeline to see where the supplemental books (the remaining books) add to the story of salvation.

Next week I'll list the 12 time periods and the 14 books of the Bible that tell the story.






