


LIVING OUR FAITH

Last weekend I shared part of the message from the missionary's homilies who visited our parishes at the end of June. Since then, a few people have asked for more information about St. Camillus and his order.



The Red Cross of St. Camillus

St. Camillus is the Patron Saint of the Sick, Hospitals and Healthcare Workers.

St. Camillus de Lellis, founder of the Order of St. Camillus, or "Camillians" obtained the privileged of wearing a red cross on their black habit from Pope Sixtus V in 1586.

The cross invoked in the sick and dying, feelings of faith, hope and confidence as

they recalled the passion, death and resurrection of our Lord. It served as a reminder of the compassionate love of Jesus to the sick and of the solemn commitment of service to the sick which the priests and brothers embrace.

Glorious St Camillus, turn your merciful eyes upon those who suffer and those who care for them.

Grant to the sick, Christian resignation and trust in the goodness and power of God.

Make those who take care of the sick be generous and lovingly dedicated.



Kateri Tekakwitha, the 'Lily of the Mohawks' was the daughter of a Mohawk chief and a Roman Catholic mother. Kateri (baptized Catherine) Tekakwitha (1656-1680) forms a unique bridge between the Native American community and the Church. She is the first Native American to be proposed for sainthood. Kateri was beatified by Pope John Paul II in 1980 and canonized in 2012 by Pope Benedict XVI. St. Kateri

Tekakwitha retained her faith and love for Christ in the face of overwhelming hostility and debilitating illnesses. She was known for her life of virtue and is a powerful role model for converts to the Church, young people striving for chastity, and anyone looking to deepen their own prayer life. She is also a shining example that God's call to holiness is truly universal and is heard by men and women in all walks of life and all ages. She was also known as a miracle worker. She died when she was only 24 years old. Saint Kateri Tekakwitha is the patron of environmentalists and orphans. Her feast day is July 14.
