

IN OUR PARISH COMMUNITY

2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time
John 2: 1-11

The wedding feast at Cana is an incredibly relatable passage from scripture. Who among us hasn't been an invited guest to a wedding reception and for many we have also been the hosts of such a happy occasion. This makes it much easier to place yourself within the story.

Let's consider a couple specific details:

First there's the obvious event when vast amounts of water miraculously change into wine. Imagine that you are a member of the wait staff at this wedding. As a servant you're basically an "invisible person" working behind the scenes yet your eyes and ears are always open. You over-hear Mary's conversation with her son. At first Jesus seems reluctant to acquiesce to his mother's request, but she gives him her best motherly "look" and before you know it the staff's directed to fill six huge jars with water. You and your coworkers haul the empty jars down to the well and begin the arduous task of filling them to the brim. These jars weigh a ton! Next you haul them back up to the banquet. Jesus prays over the jars and asks the headwaiter to have a taste. Your mind races, "What?! He's bothering the headwaiter to taste water but wait a minute the headwaiter just said this wine tastes amazing? What in the world is going on?" Your head is spinning. We can only imagine the conversational buzz throughout the wait staff behind closed doors from this point on. "Who is this guy?" "Who is his mother?" "What is going on?" Can you visualize all the whispering, head-shaking and quizzical looks? Jesus is amazing.

Second let's ponder Blessed Mother's words to the wait staff, "Do whatever He tells you."

These are the final recorded words from Our Lady's mouth in scripture, "Do whatever He tells you." These are powerful words. You and I; we are the wait staff. We are the hands and feet of Christ on earth right now. Do we consider how Jesus is speaking to us in the here and now?

Like the loving mother that she is, Mary is telling us to follow Jesus in every waking moment, in every decision, in every breath we breathe, do whatever He tells you. These are the words of salvation. If we but only heed our loving Mother's directive and do whatever Jesus tell us; we will know everlasting peace, happiness and love.

In your minds-eye revisit the wedding feast at Cana in the role of servant and truly ponder how you'd react to this incredible miracle. Allow the sights and smells of the event to wash over you. Truly consider the role Our Lady plays in this very first miracle. Never fear going to Mary; she'll bring you right back to her Son and whisper in your ear, "Do whatever He tells you."
