

Easter is almost here!

It has been about a month since we started our Lenten journey, and we are a week away from our Church's greatest week of the year. Hopefully we all have had an opportunity to reflect on where we are in our lives, repent for our sinfulness, and have made adjustments that bring us closer to our Lord. If we have not, we have a couple of weeks to continue to work on these things. But if we think about it, shouldn't we be always looking for ways to grow closer to our Lord? We do not have to wait until Lent!

Through fall, winter, and now spring there have been many exciting things happening in our parishes that have helped us in our relationships with God and each other. Deacon Bob has offered his insight into some of our church teachings and the lives of the Saints in his adult gatherings. We have weekly rosaries on Monday night at St. Anne and before many of the Masses. Our RE programs have been preparing our students to grow in their faith and prepare for the Sacraments. Through our Parish Councils and Holy Cross's Parish Mission Planning group, our students can also participate in summer programs offered through our parishes, Camp Tekakwitha and Totus Tuus, to continue enhancing their spiritual growth. During Lent we had weekly Stations of the Cross at both Parishes, and we just finished our Flame of love Lenten Mission two weeks ago. All these things and many others that are offered at our parishes each year, help us to better prepare ourselves for Easter, when we remember what our savior has done for us through his passion, death, and resurrection.

Over the last few years, we also have welcomed many new parishioners to our communities. This is a statement about what we offer at our parishes. It is great to see our communities growing. Jesus' love is certainly working through us. This year we have two candidates that have gone through the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA, formerly RCIA) to become the newest members of our Church on the Easter Vigil. Collin Rathack will receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and First Communion. Kendall Rahmlow will receive the Sacraments of Confirmation and First Communion. This is a special time for these amazing people. Walking through this OCIA journey with these candidates has been life changing, not only for the candidates, but for those walking their journey with them. The Holy Spirit has truly been with us as we have been preparing for the Sacraments. Please pray for Kendall and Collin as they make their last preparations for these Sacraments and welcome them with open arms to our communities.
