




# **Earliest Gravestone** in the Immanuel Cemetery Restored

The earliest tombstone in the old original section of our cemetery has been restored. This is the stone that marks the grave of the first burial in our cemetery, that of Heinrich Wilhelm Ruehenpohl. He died September 1, 1850, at just 38 years old, and was buried soon after on the plot of land the congregation had purchased May 15, 1850, from Jacob and Eizabeth Grueling to serve as our first burial ground. The stone was broken many years ago by vandals and had



lain on the site of his grave since

that time. A picture of the broken stone and the restored stone are shown. We are pleased to have this significant monument restored to its prominence. former Ruehenpohl played a significant role in the schism in the Friedens Church that led the Lutheran part of that congregation to leave and found Immanuel Lutheran Church in September 1847.
