### Wrap-up to the Bishop's Visit

Thanks to everyone who helped make Bishop Hying's visit last Sunday such a memorable event. The bishop is the chief pastor of the diocese — I serve only as his delegate — so when we welcome him to *our* parish, we are in a sense welcoming him to his own.

The bishop will be back at St. Bernadette Parish on Tuesday, October 8, for a meeting with the priests of our vicariate. We will begin with Mass at St. Bridget's Church at 11:00 a.m., which parishioners are also invited to attend.

In his homily last Sunday, the bishop asked to look upon the crucifix and see in it the head of Jesus lowered to offer us a kiss and his arms spread wide to embrace us, yet his feet nailed to the cross. On this day of Our Lady of Sorrows, let us stand before the cross with Mary.

### On the Cover

September 15, the "octave day" of (the eighth day from) the feast of Our Lady's Nativity on September 8 and the day after the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, is the feast of **Our Lady of Sorrows**. However, Sunday, as the weekly feast of the Resurrection, takes precedence over holy days of lesser eminence.

The image shows Mary in the center praying in sorrow, pierced by seven swords. Around her are shown her seven greatest sorrows in life (clockwise from the lower right):

1. the prophecy of Simeon (Lk 2:25-35)
2. the flight into Egypt (Mt 2:13-15)
3. the loss of the Child Jesus for three days (Lk 2:41-50)
4. the carrying of the cross (Lk 23:27-31; Jn 19:17)
5. the crucifixion (Jn 19:25-30)
6. the deposition (Lk 23:50-54; Jn 19:31-37)
7. the burial of Christ (Is 53:9; Lk 23:50-56; Jn 19:38-42; Mk 15:40-47)

The text is the "invitatory antiphon" for the feast, recited in the style of a responsorial psalm with the opening psalm of the daily office (the breviary).

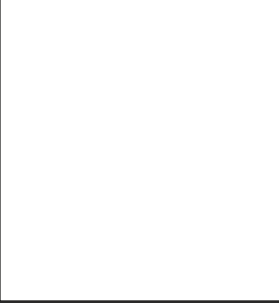

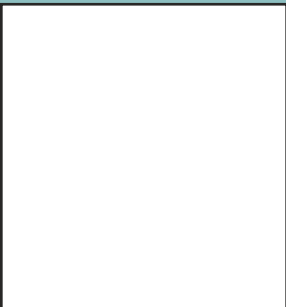
