# Blessings from the Holy Land of Jesus Christ

Our This morning (Tuesday, 5/23), I arrived in Israel with a fine group of Catholics from across our Diocese of Springfield for an 11-day pilgrimage. During this time, we will visit and pray in the most important places where our Lord Jesus, his earliest disciples, and the first Christians lived and worked/walked. We will offer Masses daily in these holy sites and read the scripture passages about these places. We will also listen to and ask questions of our tour guard.

Some of these places we will visit include the Sea of Galilee in John 21:1-14, Jesus' Boat Museum in Luke 8:22-25, Mt. Beatitudes site of the Sermon on the Sea in Luke 8:22-25, the Church of the Multiplication of loaves and fishes in John 6:1-15, House of St. Peter in Capernaum in Matthew 8:14-17, the site of the Annunciation in Luke 1:26-38,


Tabor in Luke 9:28-36, Cana site of Jesus' first miracle in John 2:1-12, place of Jesus' baptism in Jordan river in Matthew 3:13-17, Jericho Mount of Temptation in Luke 4:1-13, the sycamore tree of Zacchaeus in Luke 19:1-10, Church of the Good Shepherd in Jericho in John 10:1-18, Bethany and the Tomb of Lazarus in John 11:1-44, Emmaus appearance in Luke 24:13-35, and the site of Mary's visit to Elizabeth in Luke 1:39-56.

We will also visit the Shepherd's Fields in Luke 2:8-20, Hebron and the Tombs of the Patriarchs in Acts 7:9-16, the Pool of Bethesda in John 5:1-9, the site of Jesus' flagellation in John 19:1-16, Mount of Olives in Luke 22:39-46, site of Jesus' Ascension in Luke 24:50-53, Pater Noster Church in Matthew 6:9-13, Dominus Flevit in Luke 19:41-44, Garden of Gethsemane in Matthew 26:36-46, David's Tomb in 1Kings 2:10-12, the Cenacle (Upper Room) in Acts 1:12-26, and several other places of deep scriptural and historical significance like the Church of St. John the Baptist, the Church of the Nativity, the Milk Grotto, the basilica of St. Helen in Bethlehem, the Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa, the Church of the Holy Sepulcher and Church of St. Anne in Jerusalem, the Bethphage, Mary's Tomb, Church of All Nations, Mt. Zion, the Dormition Abbey, and the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu.

This is not my first time visiting the Holy Land, but my first time leading a group here for a pilgrimage. Some of us already know how important I consider pilgrimages in our faith and spiritual life. I have had the privilege to travel to several countries for missions, academic and evangelical conferences, and pilgrimages. Words can never be enough to articulate the oneness, apostolicity, holiness, and universality of the Church that I have witnessed in these travels. The impacts of these exposures and experiences on my life as a person, a Catholic Christian, and a priest are divine gifts I will forever cherish in my life and ministry.
