### **From the Desk of Father Haan**

#### ***Two Days, One Joe***

One saint gets **two** feast days each year? I think it's the least we can do for him, to be honest. For far too long, Saint Joseph has been neglected in Catholic spirituality and devotion. While the Blessed Mother has a singular and preeminent role in the history of salvation, the task entrusted to Saint Joseph is also monumental: to provide for and protect the Mother of God and the Son of God.

**March 19<sup>th</sup> is the Feast of Joseph, Husband of Mary.** It recognizes the virtuous and heroic way Joseph lived his vocation to marriage and to fatherhood. It's been in the Roman calendar since the 15<sup>th</sup> century.

**May 1<sup>st</sup> is the Solemnity of St. Joseph the Worker.** It is a more recent designation, established by Pope Pius XII in 1955 to recognize the great dignity of professional work, as well as counter the various "May Day" celebrations sponsored by Communist countries.

I think the Church has it in the right order: we are first called to become holy within our vocation (marriage, religious life, etc.) That comes first. But we also must be sanctified in and through our daily work, domestic and professional, which gives us dignity as co-workers in God's divine plan.

If God the Father entrusted such important people as Mary and Jesus to Joseph's care, shouldn't we entrust ourselves and our spiritual lives to his paternal care as well? This is the idea behind Father Donald Calloway's *Consecration to St. Joseph* book. It has been a best-seller this past year for good reason. It is a 33-day preparation for consecration to St. Joseph, covering his mission, his various titles, and his numerous virtues. Father Calloway explains that a consecration to Saint Joseph is essentially "To acknowledge that he is your spiritual father, and you want to be like him...to entrust yourself entirely to his paternal care so that he can lovingly help you acquire his virtues and become holy." He goes on to write, "Joseph's example and protection are the only way out of the confusing mess we are in. Who else can we turn to who can help us understand what marriage and the family are all about if not the Head of the Holy Family and the Terror of Demons?...God is telling his Church that, in order to defend marriage and the family, elevate morals, recover lost ground, and win souls for Jesus Christ, we need to bring St. Joseph onto the battlefield" (pp.4-5).

***Would you consider joining us in this 33-day preparation, starting on March 30<sup>th</sup> and concluding on Joseph's Feast Day on May 1<sup>st</sup>?*** I especially appeal to fathers to lead their families through this spiritual experience. If you are interested, either head to the Village Dove bookstore or head to [www.consecrationtostjoseph.org](http://www.consecrationtostjoseph.org). Beyond this, ***would you consider coming to Mass to celebrate St. Joseph's two feast days?***

There will be other devotions and education on Saint Joseph at SLDM throughout the coming year. Hopefully you will notice in the narthex the beautiful display with a gorgeous stained-glass image of Saint Joseph, created by parishioner Mireille Wannemuehler. There is also information about our sister parish in Brazil.

May St. Joseph, patron of the Universal Church, protect our families and our parish family.







## 2021 EASTER VIGIL AND EASTER SUNDAY MASSES WILL REQUIRE RESERVATIONS TO ATTEND

At St. Louis de Montfort, we strive to thoroughly plan for our Easter liturgies and other seasonal offerings in order to ensure as many people have a life-changing encounter with Christ as possible. This normally involves many detailed logistics, but even more so within our current pandemic. With social distancing in the church and the gym, the capacity of our space is drastically reduced. To prevent the frustrating situation of anyone being turned away due to a lack of space, **we will be utilizing an online reservation system for all Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday Masses.**

**The reservation link will go live at 7AM on Monday, March 15, 2021.**

**After that time, please visit <https://sldmeaster.eventive.org/> to make your reservations.**

### **Items of note when making your reservation:**

- You will be reserving the quantity of seats for the number of people attending with your group.
- There is a cost listed of \$0.00 - please know there is NO fee to reserve your space.
- Doors will open 30 minutes prior to the scheduled Mass time.
- Please arrive no later than 10 minutes before Mass is scheduled to begin.
- Remember, masks continue to be required at Mass.
- If you need help making your reservations, please contact the parish office at (317)842-6778 **after 7AM on March 15th.**
- If your circumstances change and you will not be able to attend, please contact the parish office as soon as possible so that we are able to make that space available for others.
- Once seats at a particular Mass are filled, the reservation link will be closed.



As faithful stewards of God’s many gifts, Saint Louis de Montfort understands its responsibility to care for our brothers and sisters in need. Your request will be reviewed in confidence by the parish Tithing Committee. You will be contacted once the review process is complete. Thank you for your interest and desire to help those in need.

**Guiding Principles** are used to ensure that the Sunday collection tithe supports our brothers and sisters in need. Our focus is on the poor in the greater community. The following objectives are used by the Tithing Committee when determining an organization or cause to be supported.

- ◇ Preference is given to organizations or causes whose mission is to directly assist the needs of the disenfranchised and the poor in general, Matthew 25:35-36. Capital campaigns are not considered.
- ◇ The mission or objective of any organization or cause that is supported by the offertory tithe must not conflict with the teachings and practices of the Roman Catholic Church.
- ◇ Tithing to SLDM ministries is confined to our outreach services such as, but not limited to, the Sally Burton food pantry, Noblesville senior food delivery and the Saint Nicholas fund, 100% of these funds directly support our brothers & sisters in need.
- ◇ All tithe requests must be submitted on an SLDM parish tithe request form yearly by an active parishioner. The outreach organization or cause can be designed to assist those in need locally, nationally or in the international communities.
- ◇ Tithe recipients will be announced at each Mass before the offertory collection is taken (10% of all collections are then donated). Tithe committee, at its discretion, may also request a detailed usage of our tithe funds from organizations that the parish supports. The committee meets on an as-needed basis (usually 3 or 4 times a year) but request can be submitted at any time.





Congress has authorized a special certificate and pin for each living veteran who served at any time on active duty in the US Armed Forces, regardless of location during the Vietnam War era.






