### *From the Desk of Father Haan*

#### *Your Barley Loaves*

The Gospel this weekend is Saint John's account of the Feeding of the 5,000, which serves as a prelude to the Bread of Life discourse that Jesus gives in the Capernaum synagogue. The sixth chapter of John's Gospel is intensely Eucharistic, and it will serve as the Gospel at Mass for the next four Sundays (except for the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary on August 15). But the entire Eucharistic lecture is kicked off with this wondrous multiplication of food. Of course, Our Lord Jesus is the central figure and protagonist in this incredible miracle, but let's not overlook the role of the unnamed youth. When the apostles are brainstorming options to provide sustenance for the famished horde, "Andrew, the brother of Simon Peter, said to him, 'There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish; but what good are these for so many?'"

He was an insignificant young man who possessed an insignificant amount of food. But it is what he had, and the Lord could make use of it for his purposes. I can only imagine the effect it must have had on the boy, to see his meager offering be used in such an incredible way.

And in the process, he had come face to face with his Redeemer. From that moment on, his life would no longer be insignificant, because he would be following and serving Jesus.

When I was discerning my vocation in college, first at Purdue and then later at Notre Dame, I found great hope in the figure of this boy on the hillside at Capernaum. I would think to myself, "I'm just an Indiana farm boy who grew up dreaming of playing sports for a living, what good could I be as a priest for so many?" Somehow God managed to take the raw material of my flawed humanity and somehow uses it for His purposes, often multiplying the spiritual fruit of my efforts, much to my surprise.

The same goes for each member of this parish. Each of us has something to offer the Lord, no matter how insignificant we might think it is. He could be asking you to be a catechist or a volunteer with youth ministry, an usher or a lector, the list goes on and on at SLDM. But you do have something that Our Lord wants to use for his purposes, and it is often a matter of boldly stepping forward and giving Him a chance to spiritually multiply it. Hopefully, you have seen our advertisements for the **"Kickoff Event" being planned for August 29<sup>th</sup>, from 12:30-3pm**. It should be a great time, with food, music, and fun. Relationships with fellow parishioners can be developed at fun events like this, but it will also serve as a Ministry Fair, exposing you to all the ways you can contribute to the building up of the Church.

We live in a consumer society which trains each of us to approach everything as if we were walking into a retail store: identify what I want, find the best deal, get what I want, get out. And I'm afraid this learned attitude sometimes seeps into our approach to the parish: find a convenient Mass time, get what I want, get out. But we all must admit: there is a hungry crowd in Fishers (and beyond) who are starving for the saving Truth and grace of Jesus offered in His Church. And he wants you to play a role in providing them spiritual nourishment.

I want you all to mark this event on your calendar and plan on attending, even if just for a little while. It should be fun! And while you are there, ponder what barley loaves you have that the Lord might want to multiply in the Church. You will find that your life will be forever significant because you will be following and serving Jesus.

The Department of Defense commemorating the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Vietnam War wants to recognize, thank and honor United States military veterans who served during the Vietnam War.

Congress has authorized a special certificate and pin for each living veteran who served at any time on active duty in the US Armed Forces, regardless of location during the Vietnam War era.

### Scholarship Granting Organization

By far, one of the best ways to make a Catholic education accessible and affordable for families who qualify, is to make a gift via our partner Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO). It not only helps us to meet the need of families who express a desire for their children to receive a Catholic education. It also is a highly tax-advantageous way of making your gift. By making your gift, designated to St. Louis de Montfort, through our SGO you can receive a state tax credit equal to 50% of the donation amount. Your gift also qualifies as a charitable deduction on federal tax returns.

As an example, a \$1,000 donation to the SGO would qualify for a \$500 state tax credit and a \$220 federal deduction (assuming a 22% tax bracket). This makes the true "cost" of the gift \$280 after the tax savings.

While there is no cap on donation amounts made by individuals or corporations, gifts will receive the state tax credit only if there are funds available. Currently, there is only about \$5.3 million in available tax credits in the fund. You can visit the Indiana Department of Revenue site to check the status of remaining tax credits.

Each year, gifts designated to SLDM via the SGO are combined with a parish subsidy to award approximately \$100,000 in financial aid. We anticipate an increase next year in the number of families who will qualify and in those families who will seek financial assistance—whether current or incoming.

Making a donation, of any size, to the SGO assures the gift of a Catholic education is possible for those families for whom it is out-of-reach financially. It also eases church and school resources to free them up for other areas of need within the budget.






