From the Desk of Father Haan...

Back to **SCHOOL**

I know there are exceptions, but nearly every student I've spoken with from St. Louis de Montfort Catholic School over the last couple of weeks is *excited* to get back to school. They look forward to seeing their friends, making new friends, meeting their new teachers, and beginning the learning process. Several public schools started classes this past week, and our school starts August 12th. Last year our school had a record enrollment of 510 students. This year we have 547 enrolled!

It's not just the students that are excited. Teachers also look forward to returning and living their calling as a Catholic school educator. Each teacher is aware of their responsibility and goal of supporting parents in making disciples of the children. And for the record, I'm excited, too! The people and activity on our parish campus increases exponentially when school is back in swing.

So much goes into planning for a new school year, but the most important preparation is spiritual. Our school faculty and staff, alongside our parish staff, will have a day-long retreat on Monday to renew their love for Christ and be even more ready to share that divine love with their students.

Each and every Catholic should mirror this two-fold attitude: an eagerness for learning more about the faith and an awareness of the need to prepare to share the faith with others. Whether it is reading solid Catholic books, listening to Catholic podcasts, or watching various offerings on Formed.org or EWTN, our love for Our Lord should drive us to know more about the One we love. With all the materials out there, none of us should be able to say we don't know our Catholic faith!

Parents of school children: be sure to pray with your children each morning before sending them off to school! As a child, I usually rolled my eyes when my dad and mom insisted on a short Scriptural devotional reading, a Guardian Angel prayer, and other prayers before school, but those things stuck with me and bore fruit.

Pray for the staff, faculty, students, and families at our school, and for all students starting a new school year. While exciting, it can be a time of anxiety and nerves as well, especially for new students. Our prayers can give them peace! And with so many new families in our school, we should be especially attentive to reaching out and embracing them as a part of our faith community and parish. And pray for the healing of our school community as we mourn the loss of one of our beloved students, Bradford Bego, a 2nd grader who died in a car accident and whose funeral was held this past Thursday at SLDM. Every child is a gift from God, and the seeds of faith we sow will bear eternal fruit.

Scholarship Granting Organization

By far, one of the best ways to make a Catholic education accessible and affordable for families who qualify, is to make a gift via our partner Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO). It not only helps us to meet the need of families who express a desire for their children to receive a Catholic education. It also is a highly tax-advantageous way of making your gift. By making your gift, designated to St. Louis de Montfort, through our SGO you can receive a state tax credit equal to 50% of the donation amount. Your gift also qualifies as a charitable deduction on federal tax returns.

As an example, a \$1,000 donation to the SGO would qualify for a \$500 state tax credit and a \$220 federal deduction (assuming a 22% tax bracket). This makes the true "cost" of the gift \$280 after the tax savings.

While there is no cap on donation amounts made by individuals or corporations, gifts will receive the state tax credit only if there are funds available. Currently, there is only about \$5.3 million in available tax credits in the fund. You can visit the Indiana Department of Revenue site to check the status of remaining tax credits.

Each year, gifts designated to SLDM via the SGO are combined with a parish subsidy to award approximately \$100,000 in financial aid. We anticipate an increase next year in the number of families who will qualify and in those families who will seek financial assistance—whether current or incoming.

Making a donation, of any size, to the SGO assures the gift of a Catholic education is possible for those families for whom it is out-of-reach financially. It also eases church and school resources to free them up for other areas of need within the budget.



The Catholic Ministry Appeal—Another Way to Support our Catholic Faith




