

#### **SAINT AGNES**

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

Mass on Palm Sunday is unsettling. The reality is from the very high to the lowest low. We hear a Gospel to open Mass with the jubilant and hope-filled reception of Jesus to Jerusalem and then have the reading of the Passion and Death of Christ. If it is unsettling that would be due to straining your ear to hear the story and staring by the eye of your mind to picture the reality of those monumental Mediterranean days. The Palm Sunday liturgy is a one-hour clashing of the most extreme, the humandivine drama, from our celebration of Jesus as victor to the desolation of the beloved Son on the Cross.


We would like to praise Jesus in some way that made us feel it was real, praise him in some new full-hearted way. We would like to praise him and receive him in a manner that feels powerful. If we do reach that state of lively and vibrant praise, it would be a spiritual experience unlike what we are ever used to, even if it is only momentary. But we are feeble in our worship. Feeble, dull, and tired. Palm Sunday begins with a grand welcome to Jesus into his city. The city is awakened to his holy glory, awakened to praise him.

Then his Passion.

The dark is overwhelming. He experiences the darkness, the violence, the uncivilized tyranny of rejection. And then brute pain.

The disciples couldn't stand to see it and they didn't.

And I would have gotten clear away from it. Most of you would too. But the Palm Sunday Mass will not let us slink away and to try to ignore. We are positioned like children looking through the fence of the graveyard in cold fear. And we wonder what comes next after the absolute stillness and silence.






