SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

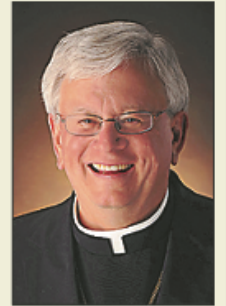

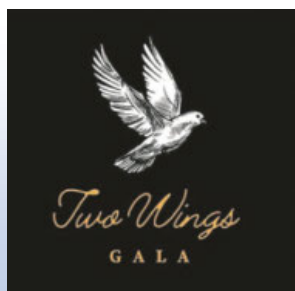

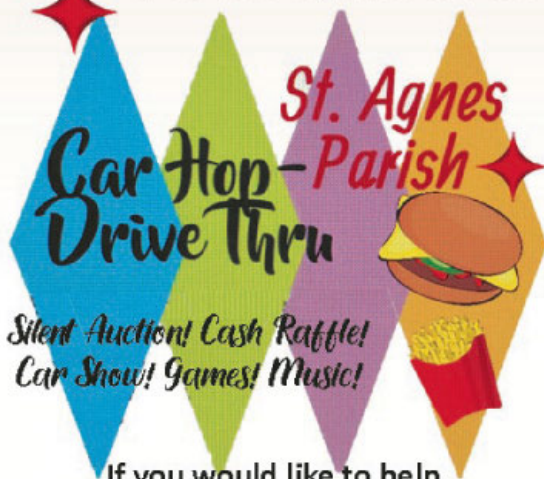

Inspiration for the Week



Do we hear and follow? Before we can welcome Jesus as the Good Shepherd, we have to hear his voice. 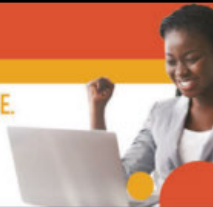
