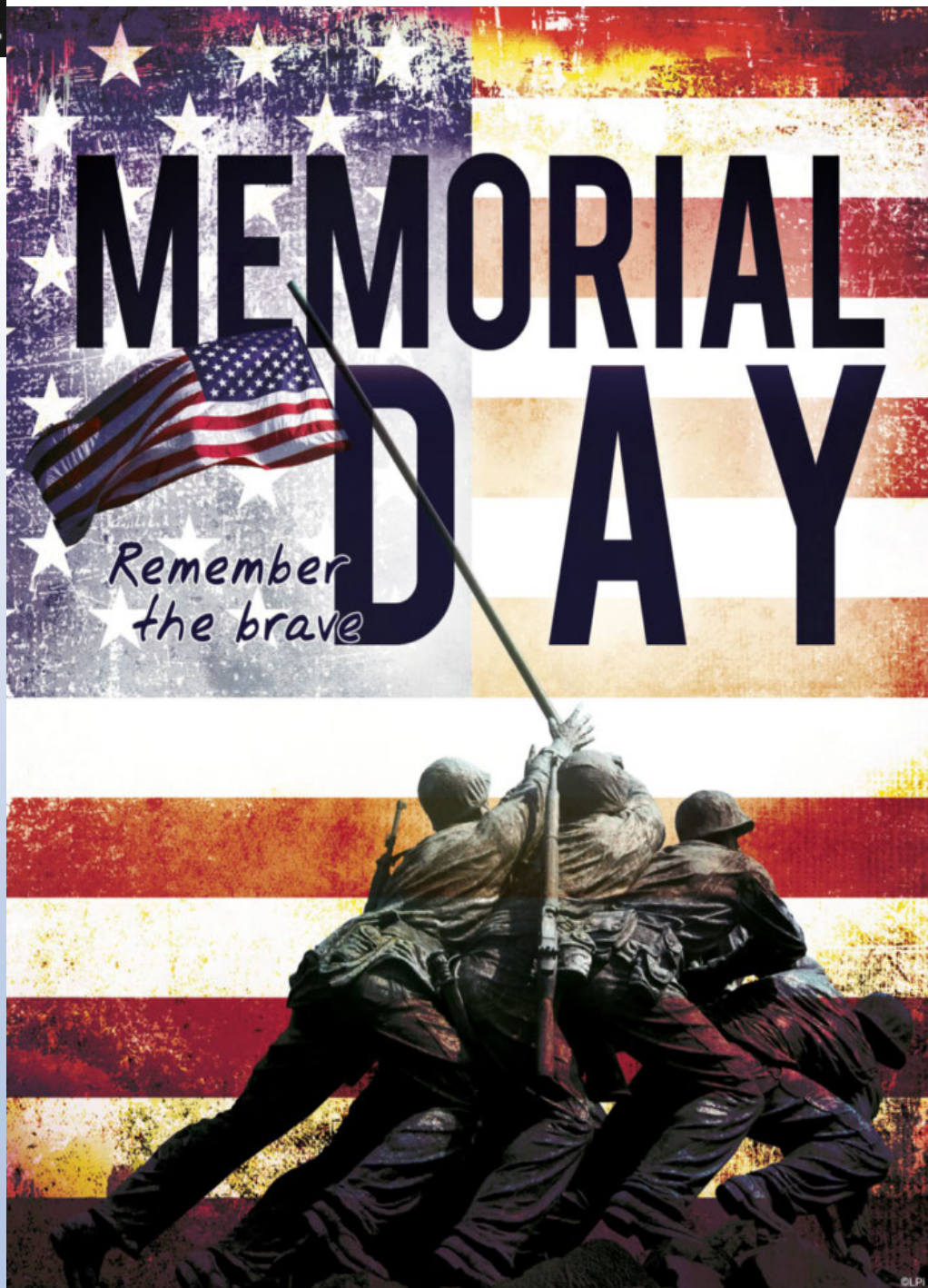

SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

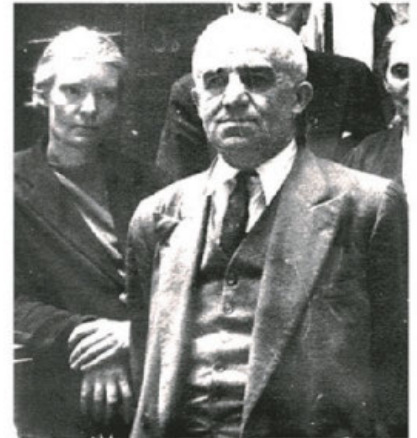

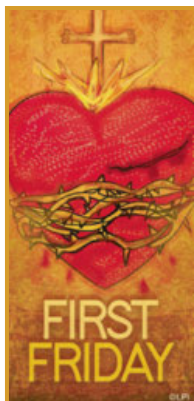
Who can be anointed? (Canon 1004)

1. "A member of the faithful who, having reached the use of reason, begins to be in danger due to sickness or old age."
2. "This sacrament can be repeated whenever the sick person again falls into a serious sickness after convalescence or whenever a more serious crisis develops during the same sickness."

Our May Widows Support Group is postponed until **June 9 at 1 PM**. This will be our last meeting before summer break. Meetings will resume in September. Please join us!

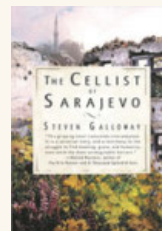

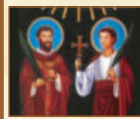

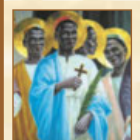
