

### **SAINT AGNES**

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

## Risen, Ascended...and Come Holy Spirit

If you're like most Catholics, it's hard to keep track of when Easter falls, when Ascension (Thursday or Sunday?) arrives and when exactly does Pentecost and the Holy Spirit come?

Let's start with Easter. In 325 AD, the Council of Nicaea decreed that Easter should be observed the first Sunday following the first full moon after the spring equinox (March 21). Simple, right?

The date therefore, is movable and can fall anywhere between March 22<sup>nd</sup> and April 25<sup>th</sup>. Forty-six days before that is Ash Wednesday. Wait...isn't Lent 40 days? Yes, but Sundays don't count.

The Ascension of our Lord is 40 days later...but not really. It's 39 days to Ascension Thursday but the traditional date in most US Dioceses is celebrated the following Sunday...this year on May 29th...42 days after Easter.

Then it gets easier...Pentecost (\*meaning 50) and the arrival of the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, is always TEN days after the Ascension.

It can be confusing to be a Catholic at times!

But it's worth the wait. The Holy Spirit, the third person of the Holy Trinity brings peace and Grace to our lives and helps us answer God's universal call to holiness.

When we abandon ourselves to be led by the Holy Spirit, he raises us little by little and guides us. At the beginning, we may not even be able to tell, slowly, a light shines within and allows us to see all our actions are directed toward God. Father Louis Lallemant, a 17<sup>th</sup> century Priest of the Society of Jesus calls this a purification of the heart and a detachment of the will.

He speaks of three steps:

Faithfully obeying God's wishes as far as we know them.

Frequently renewing the resolution to follow God's will. It takes an act of will on our part to leave our will behind!

Asking the Holy Spirit for the light and the strength to accomplish God's will to the best of our ability.

Now that we have the calendar straight...come Holy Spirit come!




