SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

The Priest Project

A few months ago the Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help began a prayer effort entitled the "Shepherd Project," offering prayers each day for a different U.S. Bishop. As part of the daily Mass intentions, a specific Bishop from every Diocese in our nation is prayed for by name. An email is sent to them letting them know about this prayer. The response has been awesome. Many Bishops have offered thanks, prayers in return and plan for a visit to the only fully approved Marian Shrine in our country.

Who can't use more prayers? Bishops are under tremendous pressure especially in the times we find ourselves in.

This caused me to think about another group of leaders who are also under great pressure and are in need of our constant prayer...the priests and seminarians of OUR Diocese of Green Bay.

So, we are launching our own prayer effort...the Priest Project. Effective this week, we will be praying for a specific priest or seminarian, by name at each Mass daily. We will email each of them a few days ahead of the date to let them know of our intention at Mass.

We pray for their safety and protection and blessings upon their vocation. The prayer below is a great daily prayer for current priests. Cut it out and add to your daily prayer regimen.

Daily Prayer for Priests

O Jesus, I pray for your faithful and fervent priests; for your unfaithful and tepid priests; for your priests laboring at home or abroad in distant mission fields; for your tempted priests; for your lonely and desolate priests; for your young priests; for your dying priests; for the souls of your priests in purgatory. But above all, I recommend to you the priests dearest to me: the priest who baptized me; the priests who absolved me from my sins; the priests at whose Masses I assisted and who gave me your Body and Blood in Holy Communion; the priests who taught and instructed me; all the priests to whom I am indebted in any other way. O Jesus, keep them all close to your heart, and bless them abundantly in time and in eternity. Amen.




Patriot Day


