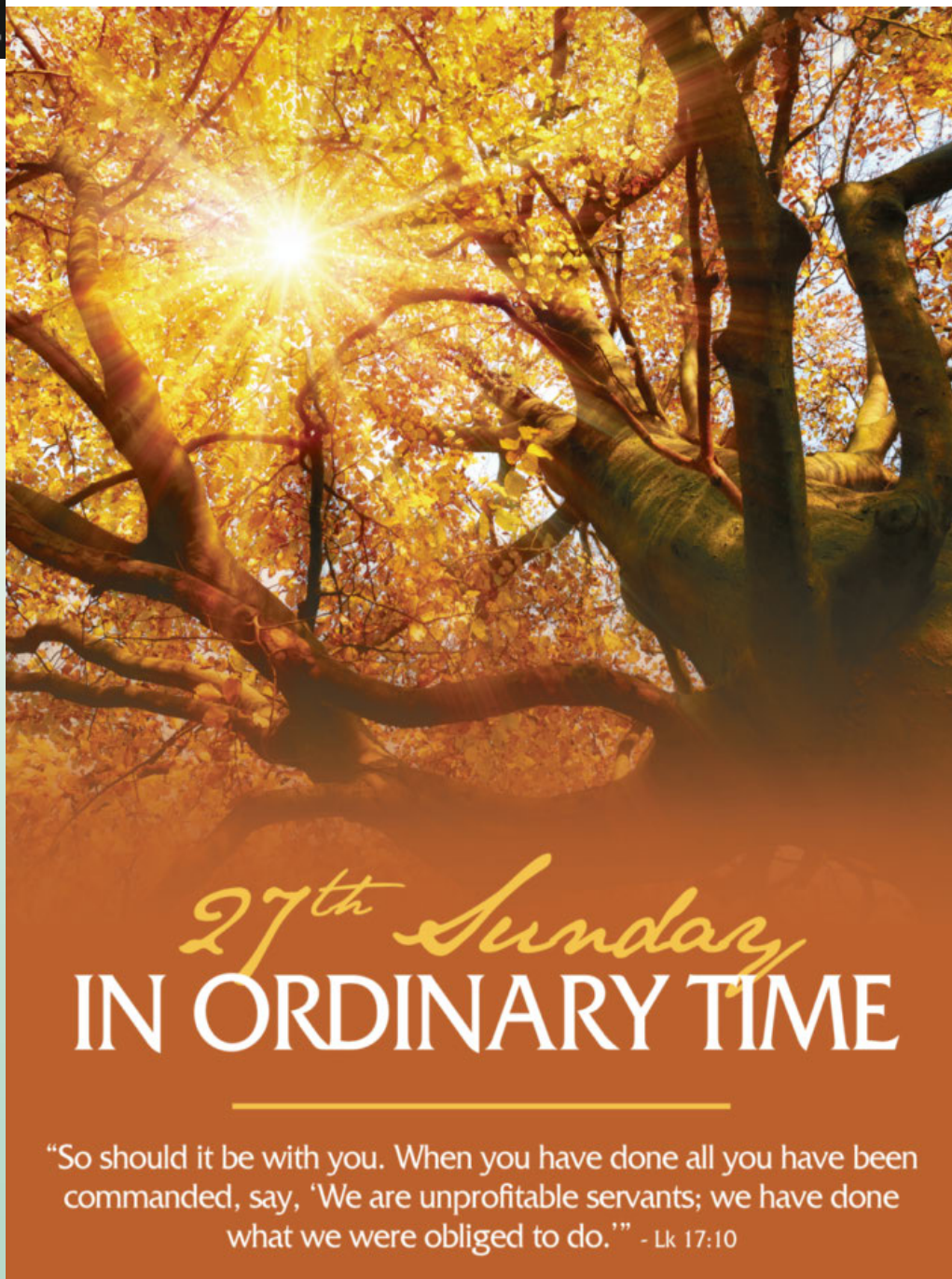

SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

On Sunday morning, September 18th, after the 8:00 Mass I had a conversation with a couple guys here for the Bears game. I'd seen them during Mass in the back of section two. I often will see people here for Mass on days of Packers' home games and guess that they might be here for the game from elsewhere. I guessed correctly with these guys as they were here from California. We had a nice conversation. I asked where they were from---about an hour outside of L.A.---and I shared with them about my times of having been in Cali. In my second year of priesthood I went to a Camoldolese retreat house near Carmel. I flew into Monterey (boy, were my arms tired) and then drove down Hwy. 1 along the coast. The retreat house is situated in a slightly wooded serene mountainous spot overlooking the Pacific. I had another trip to California about ten years ago to visit a friend in Los Angeles. We went to see Electric Light Orchestra play at the Hollywood Bowl. That was an amazing concert.

But the point of the story is this. A couple of guys took the time to honor the Lord and joined us for Mass even though they were traveling. Also-- it's pretty likely that we have guests here any given Sunday. Hopefully they appreciate finding their way to St. Agnes and their time of prayer at Mass. Hopefully the feeling people get here each week is polite, friendly, gracious, and hospitable. The church/the parish is a refuge and a home for kindness and peace.
