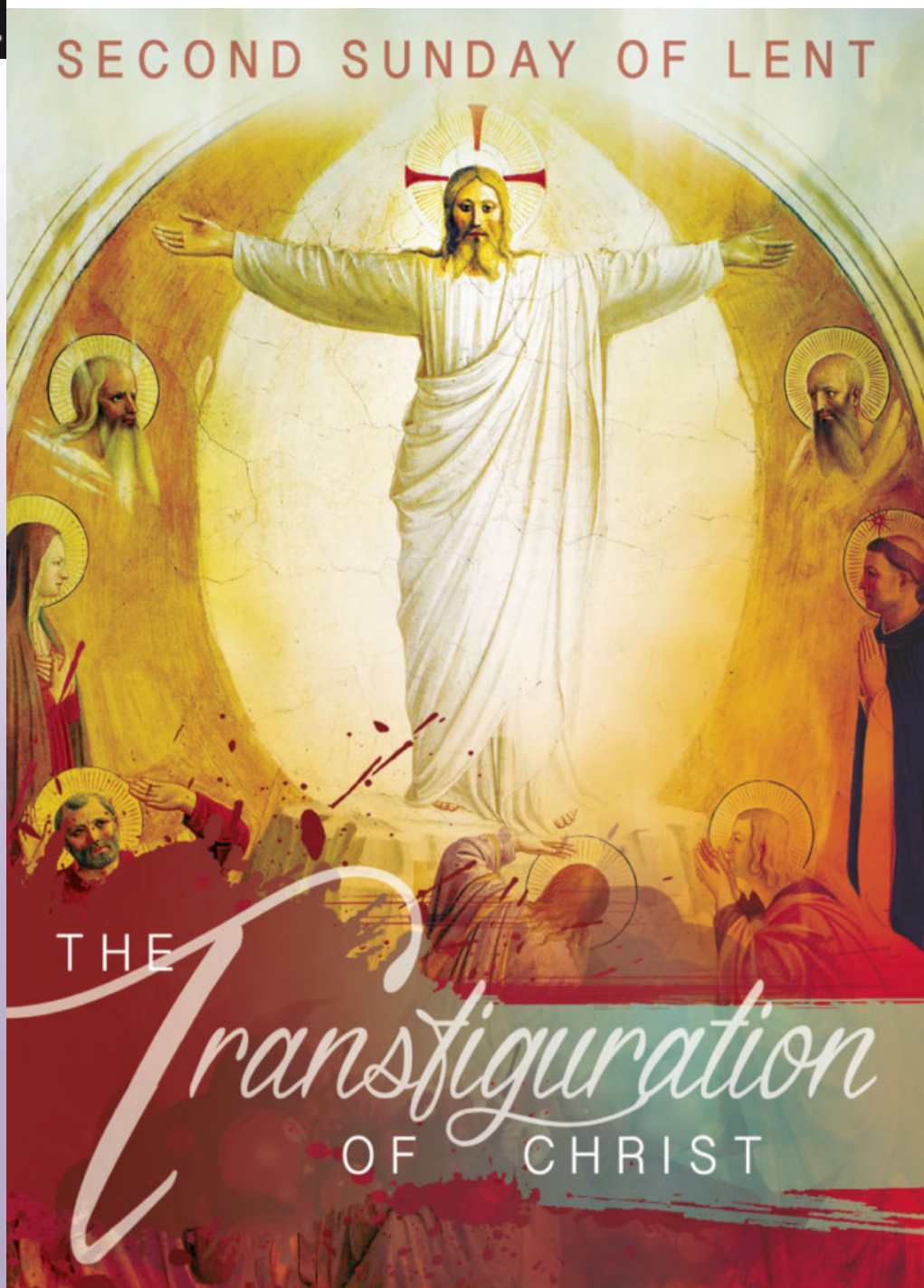

SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

Happening In This World

Malawi. Malawi is a land-locked country in southeastern Africa that is bordered by Zambia, Tanzania, and Mozambique. Malawi is one of the world's poorest countries. Homelessness is epidemic. There are many homeless children but there are also many homeless elderly. The word on Malawi for grandmother is *gogo*. Many *gogos* are among the poorest of the poor. The Pontifical Mission Society is a group of missionary societies under the jurisdiction of the Pope. It includes the Missionary Childhood Association. It was children in Malawi who have helped out through the MCA to provide housing for some of the elderly. It was children who raised the funds to provide a home for a poor 70 year-old woman named Nachisale in the rural community of St. Joseph Ludzi Parish in the Archdiocese of Lilongwe.

Thank you very much to Ron Blohowiak and the Knights of Columbus for all their time and work for the recent Chicken Booyah weekend. The funds for the recent booyah sale benefited the Diocesan Seminarians. Also some of the Chicken Booyah was shared with a couple local places. I dropped off two pails on the same Sunday afternoon at House of Hope. Cindy Herm reported that five pails of Booyah were brought to The Safe Shelter and went over very well. The guests at the shelter said it was great and they loved it. Of course they would. It was great eating! And our St. Vincent de Paul members also served a shelter meal with chicken sandwiches, a fresh fruit platter, and cherry cheese-cake cupcakes.

We are a few weeks into this year's Bishop's Appeal. Gifts to the Appeal support many missions of the diocese and reach many people: young people through youth events, people who receive counseling at Catholic Charities, and for the training and formation of people who minister in pastoral care. 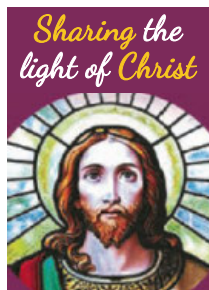

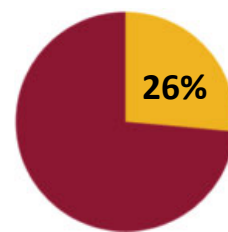

(PRACTICING) CATHOLIC

The Long Walk

The walk down from Mount Tabor after the Transfiguration must have been a long one for Peter, James, and John. How differently they must have viewed the world with the eyes that had seen what they had just seen. How uncertain they must have been.

I think it's important to remember that, on the mountain, they were amazed, yes — but first, they were afraid. We are given the image of these three grown men — these saints, these giants of salvation history — cowering in fear at the voice of God. It was not until Jesus touched them that they could even bear to look up.

Christ was transfigured on Tabor, but in a way, the disciples were transfigured as well. We are all changed by what we see and what we hear. That change can be hard because knowledge is hard. Truth is hard. Sometimes cowering is easier.

Go forth, God told Abram. I will make of you a great nation.

Rise, Christ told his disciples. And do not be afraid.

I spend too much time cowering in fear at the voice of God. I cower even when the voice whispers into my heart instead of booming from the clouds. When it's the start of a hard day or a tough conversation. When it's the middle of a half-finished battle, big or small. When I know where Christ is and what he is asking, but I'm afraid because the walk down the mountain is so long, and the world that awaits me is so uncertain.

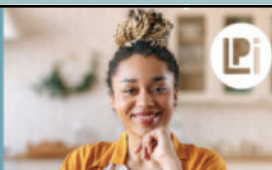
