

#### **SAINT AGNES**

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

**Bulletin Deadline** Monday Noon Happy Easter!

God became man in the person of Jesus. Our happiness is light of the world on Christmas Day. This is named the Incarnation - God embodied, in the flesh, real, living, breathing, loving, healing, suffering, dying. Easter is the high point to the Christian year, the most splendid day on the calendar. The empty tomb. Was it a hoax or mirage? Or was it the sign of life? Was it the sign and the ultimate reality of God? It was the sign of divine reality above the dying out mythologies. Jesus the Christ who said he was the way, the truth, and the life was living again in the flesh, in a real resurrected body. The rest of death led to the rising life. All the rest is history. And the Lord of history is the Lord of life.

"Blessed are you, O Lord, the God of our ancestors, praiseworthy and exalted above all forever; And blessed is your holy and glorious name, praiseworthy and exalted above all for all ages."

We honor his dying and rising repeatedly, continuously, faithfully. The children of life come together in the Spirit each Sunday to give good praise and honor to God the Father and Jesus the Redeemer. Sunday is our rest, our history, and a home. We belong to the eternal life of Christ. So we honor his life each Sunday. He makes himself present in the Mass for our present life and future rising. His presence is named the Eucharist. Eucharist translates meaning thanks. Jesus is alive and I thank him. The value of thanksgiving is never without hope and hopefulness.



The Mass for when we have had a family member die is highly valued. Having a funeral Mass is what we do in the Catholic faith. For various reasons people have forgotten this or don't understand it. I am willing to offer the prayers when I am called for a request to do a service at the funeral home but I am usually wondering why there would not be a funeral Mass. It is the Mass of Resurrection and it is offered for the soul and life of the person who died. The prayers of the Mass are for many reasons: support and consolation in the time of mourning, thanksgiving for the life of the loved one, commending them into God's care and peace, and praying for their soul in the resurrection of Christ. There is now a fresh new Easter Candle in church. It was blessed and lit from the fire at the vigil Mass on Easter Saturday night. That candle is in the front of church for every funeral Mass where it burns to show the light of Easter.

Also when we have funerals we place a small cross with their name on it in the narthex on two boards near the Confessional. We then remember all those from the parish who died in the past year at the time of All Souls Day, usually at the Sunday Mass preceding All Souls Day. At the Masses that weekend the crosses are set on a table in the front of church for a family


