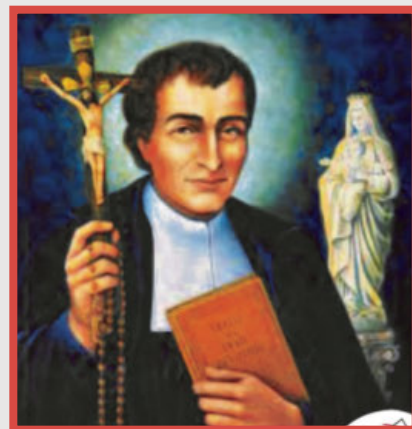
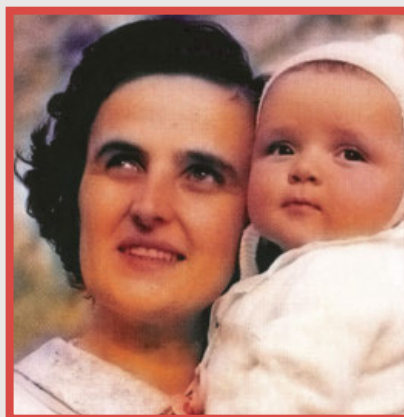

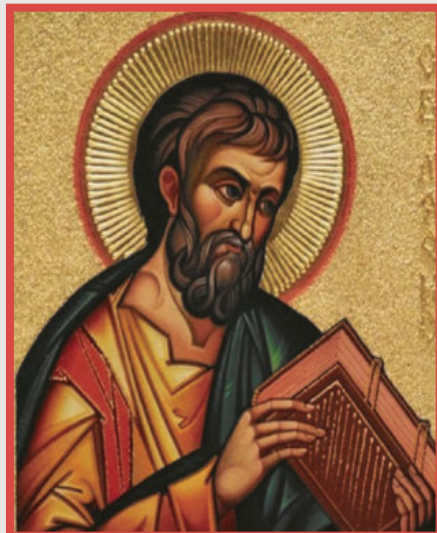

SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

Sacrament of Reconciliation

Ushers

We could always add more ushers. There is a notice for it in the bulletin every week. Some of the ushers' tasks are obvious: greeting/welcoming, answering questions, directions, donations and collection. But there is also the increasing concerns about safety and crisis. We need parish members who can help to be eyes and ears for the well-fare of all. Certainly not everyone who would be an usher wants to do those things that involve safety concerns and doesn't have to. But that in itself increases the need for those who can and are willing. Some Masses we are in the position of not even having but one or two ushers to take care of the basic tasks. This is especially true for the 11:00 Mass. So with one, two, or even three ushers then you can understand that this means there is very little in terms of watchfulness and readiness for emergencies. They are just simply able to take care of the regular needs. The need becomes greater in summer when people are gone or asked to not be scheduled. We see crises happening weekly in the news. All I can do is ask, as I have been for several years. But rarely will people answer this need. We have a safety and security team that discussed many issues but that means nothing if there are not people willing to monitor the church. If you are interested in helping please contact the office or another usher.

Volunteer Dinner

On May 9 we will have our Volunteer Dinner after a three year absence. St. Agnes has a huge number of people who volunteer in so many capacities and this is a way to thank you. I'm sure to leave someone out but off the top of my head I think of all the people who help with Mass-readers, servers, choirs, ushers, art and decor, the church cleaners, outside plants and gardens, council members, religious ed catechists, St. Vincent de Paul, bulletin preparation. We look forward to enjoying a meal and this time together again.

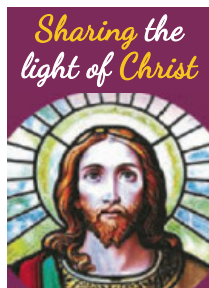

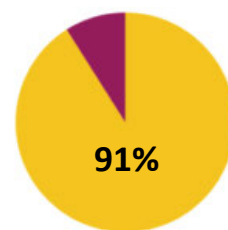

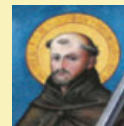
