SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

Bulletin Deadline Monday Noon

The religious education and youth ministry program at St. Agnes Parish thrives because of the dedication of our catechists and the good work put forth by our students in Kindergarten through 11th Grade. Our catechists volunteer their time from September through April. Teaching an hour and fifteen-minute religion class not only requires preparation by the catechist, but a level of courage that only the Holy Spirit can truly support. I'm filled with gratitude for the men and women from our parish who stepped up this year to share their faith and guide young minds through the workbooks, Bible study, and faith formation exercises in our program.

Students come to us after a day at school so their level of attentiveness may be understandably strained. But I hear many more stories of hard work, good behavior, and the heart-felt sharing of ideas than the opposite. And when there is a job to do, our students are not afraid of putting in the effort. Whether it's working in a food pantry or building beds for less fortunate children, as we did with the organization, "Sleep in Heavenly Peace," our students show how much they care by their actions.

This year we went beyond the workbooks to spend time with Jesus in Eucharistic Adoration, and we learned how to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet. These two practices of our Catholic faith will hopefully make a permanent home in the hearts of our children.

We're looking forward to more opportunities for spiritual growth through Vacation Bible School this June, and for the older students, F.I.A.T. 3.0 in July. And yes, please contact us if you would like to volunteer your help with either of these programs.

My thanks to Father Patrick for his guidance and patience with me on this first year as Religious Education Coordinator. I'm indebted to the entire staff at St. Agnes, especially Deacon Greg, Maureen Nesvacil and Lisa Urick.

God bless our children and their families.



GOSPEL MEDITATION Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

I recently rescued a dog. She's a terrier and rather adorable. And she's crazy about me. She could spend all day with me. But I'm a pastor at a parish and sometimes I leave her at the front desk of the church office. She constantly amazes me by her ability to distinguish between my voice and that of everyone else. If I say one word, even if I'm hidden around a corner, she'll sprint toward me and jump up into my arms.

This week the readings focus our attention to the voice of the risen Jesus Christ. Comparing his disciples to sheep and himself to a shepherd, he says, "They recognize his voice." He speaks to us and wants us to respond. When we hear his voice, we follow. Throughout this coming week, we will experience many interior promptings to receive God's love, and to love Him in return. That's his voice. Follow it into the safe and tender arms of Christ.

By contrast, some voices we will hear do not convey God's concern and love for us, but rather produce fear, despair, and other harmful mischief. Jesus calls these voices those of robbers. Does an idea or thought make it harder for you to love God? If so, run away. Let it go. It is most likely not the voice of the Risen Lord. Keep waiting for him to speak. You will recognize his voice. Then run to him as fast as you can.



Hope Center Food Pantry Volunteers Needed to Participate in Letter Carriers' Food Drive

Saturday, May 13

The Letter Carriers' Food Drive provides about 10,000 pounds of food for the Hope Center Pantry (located at 505 Clinton St., GB) We are required to provide a total of 20 volunteers to help with collection



and re-packing of our designated food. Please help out for a couple hours if you can! We encourage you to recruit among your neighbors, family and friends. Children must be at least age 10 to participate. If your student needs Community Service hours, this volunteer experience will definitely count!

Our 20 volunteers will be divided between two tasks:

Task 1: Able-bodied people are needed at the main Post Office (300 Packerland Drive) to take the collected food bags from vehicles and load them into "totes" (a.k.a. bins on pallets) for the pantries to pick up. This takes place from 11:00AM to 1:00PM on Saturday, May 13. Refreshments will be served.

Task 2: Vehicles and drivers are needed to drive mapped mail routes and pick up food. The starting and ending points for these routes is the main Post Office (300 Packerland Drive.) A suggested "team" for this is an adult driver with an energetic partner to quickly collect the bags of food. This is from 9:00-11:00AM on Saturday, May 13.

For planning, we need a commitment by the end of day on <u>Sunday</u>, <u>May 7</u>.

If you are able to help, let us know if you have a preferred task that you'd like to be assigned to.

Community of Christian Women Spring Salad Supper and Auction Monday, May 1


5 PM Doors Open | 6 PM Supper Followed by auction and meeting




