

SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

Dear St. Agnes Members:

This past six months you folks have been steady in giving food to the Hope Center Pantry. For this, and of course for your past support, we are so appreciative. Your continuing partnership is a blessing to our pantry and the many hungry families in our community. With the help of your faith community, we have been able to meet some of the continuing food insecurity needs in our area.

We remain committed to providing essential items like pasta, canned fruit and vegetables, peanut butter, cereal, kits to make a pot of chili, soups, canned meats, desserts, etc. to name a few. Funds that are donated to the Pantry are used to purchase ground beef, cheese, milk, and bread along with personal hygiene, cleaning and paper products. We also belong to the Feeding America Network where we are able to get chicken, pork and pizzas to offer our clients. In 2022 we served 3,459 families which included 6,253 children and 6,728 adults. That's quite a large net we cast doing God's good work! You have helped us meet a growing need in our community and we are very thankful.
