SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

Eucharistic Prayers

As we continue our focus on the Holy Eucharist, I wanted to take a moment to comment on the center and core of the Mass and that is the consecration of the bread and wine into the actual Body and Blood of Jesus Christ...in what we refer to as the Eucharistic Prayers.

This Eucharistic Prayer is, to a large degree, a prayer of thanksgiving (Eucharist meaning thanksgiving, of course). As a family gathers, we offer thanks to the Father of the family so the prayer begins as being addressed to our Father, not Jesus...just like a Passover or Seder meal.

Later the language will noticeably shift to first person, as Father speaks in the person of Christ and we are transported mystically to the hours from the sacrifice of God the Son, to His death.

This ancient and critical point in the Holy Mass is made up of these parts: Thanksgiving to God the Father, the Acclamation (Holy, Holy, Holy...), the "early" Epiclesis (calling down of the Holy Spirit), the Institution narrative (THIS is my Body...), the memorial offering, the intercessions, and the concluding doxology.

The prayer is an ancient Apostolic prayer that was composed in what's close to its current form around the year 215. Pope Gregory the Great standardized much of the language around the year 600. Today there are, believe it or not, 13 approved Eucharistic Prayers for the Catholic Church in the United States.

These are the standard four that we are most used to praying:

- I. "To you, therefore, most merciful Father...." (the longest one which calls down the names of numerous Saints)
- II. "You are indeed Holy, O Lord, the fount of all...." (the shortest one)
- III. "You are indeed Holy, O Lord, and all you...."
- IV. "We give you praise, Father most holy...."

The first prayer is close to the old Roman Canon, pre-Vatican II and has a "higher language" feel to it. The other three were approved in their current form in the mid-70s.

The other nine approved, but less used, Eucharistic prayers are for these purposes:

3 for children...2 for Masses of reconciliation...and 4 additional for various purposes.

This prayer is the most sacred part of the Mass, where God is truly made flesh. We remain silent during most of this prayer as a sign of reverence and contemplation, which is why we kneel as a congregation.

Let's always treat this prayer as ever ancient AND ever new, as we join in the sacrifice being offered "real time" right before our eyes. As the saying goes, we should pray each Mass as if "it is our first Mass, our last Mass and our only Mass."




