

SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

Bishop's Appeal – One by One – Carport Project

Again this year we achieved and surpassed our Diocese Bishop's Appeal. The goal assigned to us was \$72,118 and the recent number is \$79,283.

Each year we hope that we can meet the goal in 10 weeks and thereby completing Bishop's Appeal we can focus on other needs and projects. And this year that means the construction of a carport as planned to do with our One by One Campaign.

Currently we have \$152,593 in pledges received.

Pledges continue to come in over four years.

We had an account started several years ago for this project that has about \$12,000.

The carport project is estimated not to exceed \$390,000.

We will self-fund the rest of the project and reimburse the parish as pledges come in.

We have received Diocesan approval and proxy to go forward.

Thank you to Deacon Rob Hendricks our business manager for his efforts to get us to this point along with the Buildings and Grounds Committee, Mike Schlumpf, and Finance Council.

Annual Home Missions-Our Own Needs Collection Pentecost Sunday, May 28, 2023 Strengthening the Church at Home

We will have a second collection next weekend for the support of the missions in the United States. Envelopes for this appeal are in your bi-monthly packet. You may choose to support all four organizations or any one. Make checks payable to St. Agnes Parish.

The four major beneficiaries represented in this collection and their mission:

- Black and Indian Missions exists to build Christian communities among the Native American, African American and Alaskan Native peoples. All collected funds are distributed as diocesan grants to support and strengthen evangelization programs in the United State. Annually, in our Diocese, we receive grants to assist our parishes in outreach, education, and service to the people of the Menominee Indian Tribe.
- The Catholic Communications Campaign modernizes how the church communicates the joy of the Gospel nationwide and locally. This enables us to spread the Gospel message and reach more people. Half of all funds collected for the CCC remain in our Diocese to support local communication efforts.
- The Catholic University of America is the National University of the Catholic Church. Your gift enables the University to prepare the next generation of Catholic leadership, both religious and lay. Every donated dollar supports scholarships to assist financially deserving students in completing their education. Alumni include 19 Cardinals, 58 Bishops and over 12,400 priests.
- The Catholic Home Missions assists 40% of Dioceses in the United States. The fragile financial situations, poverty, vast distances, difficult terrain and lack of priests significantly affects the ability of the Diocese's mission to offer basic pastoral needs. Home Missions provides financial assistance for Mass, the sacraments and faith formation.

GOSPEL MEDITATION ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

The Ascension of the Lord

Have you ever noticed how often we use "up" and "down" to judge things? Beethoven's Ninth Symphony is "high" art, while professional wrestling is "low." If I'm having a good day, I'm on "cloud nine." A bad day means I am "down in the dumps." A successful career is "moving up the ladder." Failure in work or personal life can be "falling from the heights." Life is filled with "ups and downs" – no one has the slightest problem understanding that means life has both "good and bad."

Now consider Jesus' ascension. He ascends not just to some level slightly higher of goodness, but "above all the heavens," to use the words of Saint Paul (Eph.4:10). That expression means to the source of all goodness. He has gone all the way down — to the farthest depths of human suffering, and death. And now he has taken our humanity all the way up into God. In doing so he has demonstrated what he says in the Gospel of John to the Father: "Everything of yours is mine." He now reigns over every possible aspect of creation in and through his human nature. That's what the ascension is all about.

So what? No matter what the lows and highs, ups and down we face this week, we are totally encompassed by the one who descended and ascended. So, we should happily and confidently entrust ourselves to him. He has shown us not only his power, but especially his love, in filling all our ups and down with his presence.
