

SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

Preparation of the Gifts

Did you ever wonder about the preparation and presentation of the gifts at Mass?

This part of the Holy Mass occurs at the very beginning of the Liturgy of the Eucharist.

These gifts presented are the elements that will become Christ's body and blood. They are brought to the altar in a procession that has been in place since the beginning of our Church.

St. Justin Martyr described this practice of the faithful in about the year 155 A.D. saying:

..."then we rise together and pray, and as we before said, when our prayer is ended bread and wine and water are brought forward and the (Priest) in like manner offers prayers and thanksgivings and the people assent."

The tradition continues to this very day and in the General Instruction of the Roman Missal it states:

"It is a praiseworthy practice for the bread and wine to be presented by the faithful. They are then accepted at an appropriate place (the foot of the altar) by the Priest or Deacon to be carried to the altar. Even though the faithful no longer bring from their own possessions the bread and wine as intended for the Liturgy, as was once the case, nevertheless the rite of carrying up the offerings still keeps its spiritual significance."

"Even money or other gifts for the poor or for the Church brought by the faithful or collected in the Church are acceptable and are to be put in a suitable place away from the Eucharistic table."

The procession is accompanied by an Offertory Chant (song) which continues at least until the gifts are placed on the altar.

A tradition that has developed is that the people selected to bring the gifts forward are usually but not always representatives of the family member who is the Mass intention for that day.

They also represent all of US as we symbolically send our offerings forward, monetary or non. They carry our intentions with them which will shortly be placed on the paten as part of the sacrificial offering to God.

As with all things in the Mass there are always physical and spiritual things occurring at the same moments. WE offer our prayers and our very selves to God along with the community of believers.




