In this World Philippines-Jordan-Taiwan

One magazine is a publication about the Church and all kinds of missions to people in the near East, Africa, India, and eastern Europe. In the March 2023 issue there was an article on female immigrants from the Philippines who travel 5,500 miles away from home to work in the middle eastern country of Jordan primarily as domestic workers: housemaids, cleaners, nannies, and caregivers. They do this to provide support for their families back home sometimes being away from husbands and children for years. "According to the latest figures from the International Labor Organization in 2019, there are 24.1 million migrant workers in 12 states in the Middle East." It seems like a drastic thing to choose but that is the kind of compromising circumstances many people experience. The separation from family isn't the only difficult thing. There are also risks with the job placements as they have little say or knowledge of who they will be working for. They are placed by agencies and there is not much done to ensure their safety. Human rights groups have documented a great number of crimes against migrant workers. One woman, 40 years old, Ms. Fernando told of how she didn't leave the house unless with the children she took care of and wasn't allowed to talk to anyone outside of the family. "Employees are often trapped in jobs in which they are overworked, restricted from communication with the outside world, limited in their access to food and denied personal time." Of course along with mental/emotional abuse is the occurrence of sexual abuse.

I had never heard that there were so many Filipinos who left for work elsewhere and that it is in Jordan surprised me more. Jordan has a great number of problems itself and I'm sure poverty is one of them. So I found it puzzling that people from one poor country sought work in what I assumed was another country just as poor. Apparently there are wealthy Jordanians or at least people of enough means that they can hire domestic help. Then by coincidence I was surprised to read almost the very same story in the Fall issue of Maryknoll magazine. But in this case the story is from Taiwan where 150,000 Filipinos were working at the beginning of this year in camera and computer factories and taking care of the elderly. A Filipino priest Fr. Joyalito Tajonera said: "Migration breaks apart families. Children who only know their parents by video call. Parents trying to raise their children by long distance. Your children know your voice and face, but there's no physical contact. You can't walk them to school or go to the park. That's the life of poor people. They have to make sacrifices."

The Christian faith plays a big part in the lives of these women in both Jordan and Taiwan coming from a country which is 80% Catholic. In Jordan many of them find help, support and community from the Teresian Association, a Catholic organization who have helped migrants in the Middle East for 40 years. They gather for meals and Mass. The Teresians also help with labor disputes. In Taiwan Fr. Joyalito established a shelter he named Ugnayan, a Filipino word for 'connection', which provides all of the same things. One volunteer at Ugnayan speaking about the way things are there said: "Many times at midnight there will be migrants seeking shelter, and Fr. Joy never asks them where they're from or what religion they profess; he just asks, 'Have you eaten.'"
