Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

St. Agnes Eucharistic Adoration Chapel Celebrates Five Year Anniversary

It's hard to believe we have had our Eucharistic Adoration Chapel here at St. Agnes for five years! And what a wonderful time to bring this beautiful devotion into the limelight in these years of the Eucharistic Revival. Bishops across the nation are reminding and educating Catholics about the beauty, majesty and wonder of our Eucharistic Lord and His promise that He will always be with us. It's true! He is here. He is always here.

In the Old Testament God travels with his chosen people through the trials of their lives to the promised land. He appeared to them by day in a pillar of cloud and by night in a pillar of fire. He became physically present at the Nativity. And then at the Last Supper, he left us the promise of His Presence in the Eucharistic Bread. From the early church the remaining Eucharistic Bread was reserved to bring to the sick, and the practice of coming into the church to spend time in prayer before the Sacrament was established. The practice of Adoration waned in the 1960's and 1970's but reestablished with the prayers and promotions of St. John Paul II and his successors.

St. Alphonsus Liguori, in his writing *How to Converse Continually and Familiarly with God*, says: "When God grants you the grace of feeling his presence, and desires that you should speak to him as your most beloved friend, tell him about your feelings with all freedom and confidence. 'She (wisdom) hastens to make herself known to those who desire her.' (Wis 6:14) Without waiting for you to come close to him, he hastens towards you when you seek his love, and he presents himself to you, granting you the graces and remedies that you need. He only waits for one word from you in order to show you that he is beside you and wants to listen to you and console you. 'His ears are toward their cry' (Ps 33:16)..."

St. John Paul II placed importance on helping others understand Christ's True Presence in the Eucharist. We must come to the realization that Christ is truly present as we gaze upon Him in the Blessed Sacrament and just as he led the Israelites, he will lead us. We need only to make some time to spend with Him. He is waiting to hear our burdens, our joys, and sorrows; and He is waiting to share His grace and strength with us.

You are invited to come and spend some time with our Eucharistic Lord and consider making this a regular devotion in your week or month. New Adorers are always welcome. Sign up for a special time or specific hour of Adoration by contacting Dawn at 920-246-0913.

In the Aftermath of a Fire **SVDP Offers Assistance**


Fire! Approximately 35 people found themselves suddenly homeless after

their apartment building on Green Bay's East side caught fire earlier this month. Residents were not allowed to re-enter the building, so most lost all of their possessions.

At a resource day set up by the Red Cross, SVDP of Green Bay was one of 12 organizations offering their services. To help meet immediate needs, vouchers were provided for free clothing and shoes from the SVDP thrift stores.

As these displaced neighbors find new apartments, SVDP may help with first month rent assistance, household goods, and basic furniture. Families are met with individually to determine their needs. It truly takes a community. Parishioner donations to the thrift stores, monetary contributions, and prayerful support allow this to happen.







