SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

#### PSA

Scams are everywhere and technology and social media provide many new ways for scams to reach you. Scammers are creative and devious. One of their tactics is to play upon your generosity, compassion, and goodwill. One scam that has been going on for several years is done with texting people who know a priest or a pastor. The text pretends to be from the priest/pastor with an urgent request for some kind of assistance. It might read like this: *hi Darla- this is fr patrick. I am trying to help someone out who is in a hard situation. can you please help me with some gift cards? i need them right away.* 

This kind of thing has been going on for a few years. I know because it's been done to people who know me. They will tell me or ask me if it's real. I know it is done to other priests. It happens that a bunch of people get them at a time and then several months later it happens again.

These are always fake. You will never get a text like this from me. Think about it. If I really needed some help like this wouldn't it make more sense to call a person and speak directly to them so that they know it's real? Furthermore, we have the St. Vincent de Paul Society who we/I generally work with for assistance.

This past week I heard something very similar on the news. It was being called the grandparent scam. It's the same thing, a text, but in this case it pretends to be a grandson or daughter who needs some quick help. It might be that they are in FL on spring break and ran out of money. It will say that the grandchild cannot get ahold of their parents or ask the grandpa or grandma not to contact their parents because they didn't know they went.

Another scam are texts that appear to be from government agencies. One that has been going on is a text that states it is from the post office and might say you have a package please click on the link. There is a variety of similar scams.

Do not take seriously these bogus requests. Do not respond to them. Never give any information out. Never give your credit card number. Be aware- especially when someone is trying to rush you and make it seem like an emergency without giving much information.
