SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

What can we say about the Rosary? What is the Rosary?

The Rosary includes all forms of prayer. It is laudatory, praise, meditation, contemplation, petitionary, supplication, repentant.

The Rosary is Scriptural in both the prayers and mysteries.

The Rosary is theology.

Yet, the Rosary doesn't require a degree.

It's prayed by both theologians and simple faithful alike.

The Rosary is universal - prayed worldwide in any/many tongues, communal and individual -- in a hospital, a church, an airplane, a walk, lying in bed.

The Rosary is prayed by saints, prisoners, the blind, religious orders, children, the lonely.

The Rosary is repetitive, like the heartbeat is repetitive, like breathing is.

The Rosary points us to joy-helps us in sorrow-raises the soul for glory -illuminates the way to God.

The Rosary is a path.

The Rosary is a peacemaker.

Attention Eucharist Ministers

Beginning in October, the Office of Divine Worship, in partnership with parishes throughout the Diocese, is offering Liturgical Ministry training for parish ministers on the Vicariate level. These workshops will focus on training those who already serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion as well as those who wish to begin volunteering in this ministry.

Unlike other lay liturgical ministers, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are to be commissioned for this ministry by the Bishop. This commissioning is preceded by proper and sufficient spiritual, theological, and practical preparation to fulfill their role with knowledge and reverence. This formation is ordinarily provided by the Office of Divine Worship in partnership with the parish.

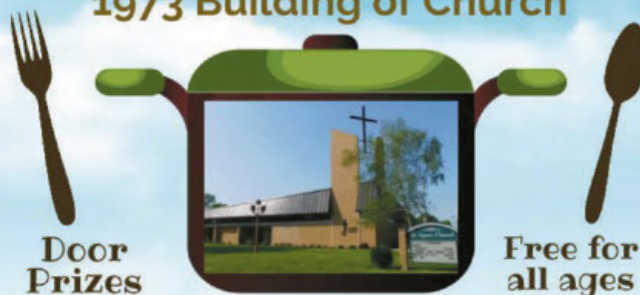
