SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

The Rosebud Program

“Blessing Bouquet” from *Elizabeth Ministry International*



We have been celebrating the Rosebud Program here at St. Agnes since 2015! This year we are making some revisions to give this ministry added visibility. Instead of once-yearly recognition, Fr. Patrick will bring the roses into a weekend Mass during the months of October, February, and June. A blessing will be asked over the families of intention and the flowers may be taken home and kept by the petitioners if desired.

Elizabeth Ministry International, the originator of the Rosebud Ministry, has designated the color of the rose to identify the need of the prayer request:

Pink: Honoring pregnancy and unborn babies

Red: Celebrating births and adoptions

White: Grieving with families suffering a miscarriage, abortion, stillbirth, or death of an infant or child

Yellow: Remembering those wanting to conceive or adopt

Blue: Troubled times

Purple: Grandparents concerns

Parishioners are invited to stop by the Prayer Corner in the narthex to offer prayer for the intentions in the vase. This ministry is designed to create a closer-knit, prayerful parish community. The reminder of the roses helps us place the value and dignity of human life at the center of people's consciousness as we prayerfully support one another, especially those who are or want to become parents. The intentions are also sent to our Parish Prayer Vine where they are prayed over by our St. Agnes Prayer warriors. And yes, prayers have been answered!

As a result, there has been a dramatic rise in Christian emigration from the Holy Land. Now, less than 1% of the population in the Holy Land is Christians.

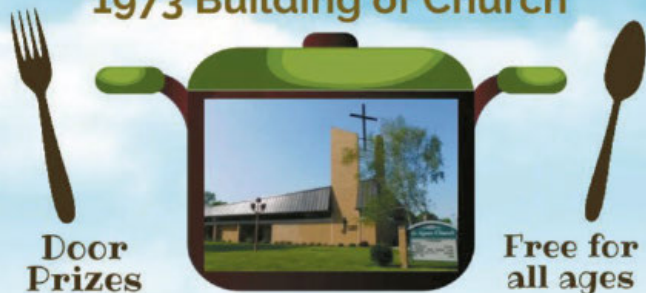

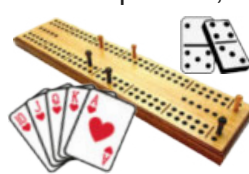

The Tax of Caesar

Too often, I confuse this world with the next.

Every day has its set of problems that need dealing with. Some are very easily discernible as problems of this world: I am tired, and I need a nap and a latte. Some are very obviously problems of eternity: I need to ask for forgiveness, but I'm not ready to admit it.

Most problems are a subtle, maddening mix of the two: my body feels tired, obscuring how tired my soul also feels, while making me very cranky, which is keeping me from asking for the forgiveness I need.

It's not that the nap and the latte *aren't* solutions. Heaven forbid! I would never propose such a thing. Sleep and coffee, I am confident, can fix almost any problem in this world. *This* world.

Too often, I slap a one-size-fits-all earthly band-aid on all my problems and rush on to the next thing. But if the problem is an issue of my soul, I may as well pay for a parking ticket in Monopoly money.

I render unto Caesar, and I forget about what is owed to God. I apply solutions meant for the here and now to problems that have eternal consequences. The spiritual problems are dismissed, shoved to the back of my mind. *For when I have time, I tell myself. For when I am ready.*

But the only time we have is now. God is no king of this earth, and he does not ask for a tax offering. He asks for our heart. He doesn't want us for minions but for children.

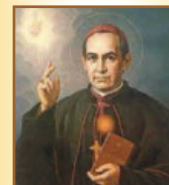

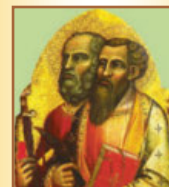

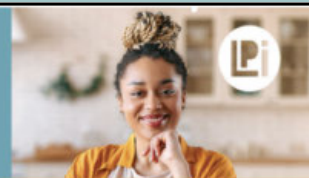
