## SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

## The Call to Conversion

Welcome to Cycle B in our Liturgical Cycle of Sunday Readings. As always, we will hear a lot of conversion stories. This weekend we listen to the call of the boy Samuel reminding us to be always attentive to what our Lord is saying to us. And we respond with him in our Psalm reading, "Here am I, Lord, I come to do your will. St. Paul then reminds us that our bodies are members of Christ? (Hmm, remind me again how that happens? Oh yes, via the Initiation Sacraments of Baptism,

Confirmation and Holy Eucharist). And finally in our Gospel we hear the calling of St. Andrew and his famous brother St. Peter.

These stories inspire us to reflect on how Jesus seeks after people. By really seeing and knowing them, he transforms and empowers them. These encounters with Jesus also invite us to wonder about ourselves and the conversion process; and challenge us to consider the ways we can encourage others in their conversion process – those who are new and those already a part of the Christian community. When did it happen that you first heard the stir of faith in your heart? As a child, young adult, yesterday? I hope - all the above. We are never finished hearing and answering the Lord.

We will soon be hearing of a revision coming to the *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults* (RCIA), which will include a change in title to *Order of Christian Initiation of Adults* (OCIA). This rite or order is the Church's process of forming and initiating adults as Catholic Christians. It is also a way that we, the baptized, who witness the process, deepen our own relationship with Christ and the Church. It's important to remember that we are all in process ☺. The call is continually ongoing for each of us, to grow in faith, to refine and develop our faith life, to deepen our personal walk with the Lord, and to share our faith with others.

The call is always open to step forward in faith! Phone the parish office if you are interested in Baptism for yourself or your child. If you are interested in receiving the Sacrament of Adult Confirmation this spring, the time of registration is now. Call the office or email [ministry@stagnesgreenbay.org](mailto:ministry@stagnesgreenbay.org) for more information and to register.

- May 19, 2024 Confirmation at St. Francis Xavier Cathedral with Bishop Ricken

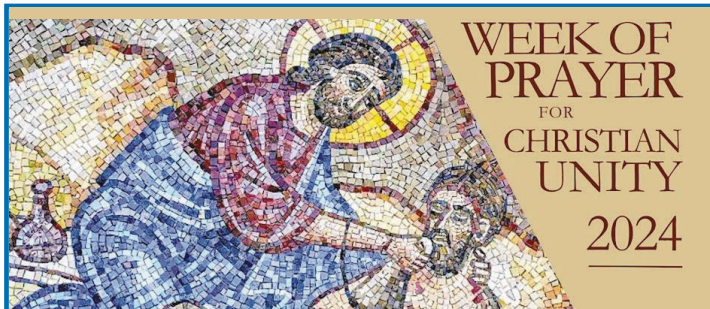

RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

### Those Who Seek the Truth

In my work as a freelance writer, I have a regular column in the archdiocesan paper writing profiles of ordinary people in the local church. Laity, religious, and clergy alike — I hound them all to give me an interview, and when I do, the answer is almost always this: “You don’t want to talk to me. There’s nothing special about me.”

I always try to convince them that there is something remarkable about everyone who is searching for the truth. It is easy to think we are not made for holiness because we are ordinary people with ordinary habits, ordinary abilities, and ordinary sins. It is easy (and very convenient) to designate holiness as something belonging to Better People. People like the saints. People like the Disciples.

The Bible gives us next to no personal information about the disciples. There is no archdiocesan newspaper profile on Andrew and Simon that can give us insight into who they were before they became St. Andrew, Inaugural Disciple and Announcer of the Messiah, and St. Peter, First Pope and the Rock-Upon-Which-Christ-Built-His-Church.

Yet I find myself insatiably curious about it. What was their childhood like? What games did they play with each other as the sun set, before their mother called them into bed? What did they think of as they fell asleep at night? What secret jokes did they share to make each other laugh? What were they afraid of? What did they hope for? Who did they want to be?

Before they were towering figures of salvation history, Simon and Andrew were just two men searching for the truth. When they looked at Christ, there was something that made it click. Perhaps they themselves could not identify what it was, but their hearts whispered it nonetheless: *There it is. We finally found it.*

Isn’t that the best we can all hope for?

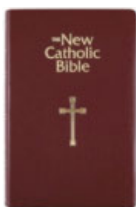
